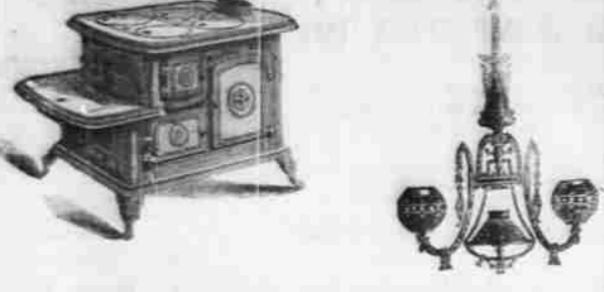

The Sunday Law

The Supreme Court of California has decided the Sunday law to be constitutional, and the Chief of Police of San Francisco has ordered the cessation of all amusements on that day.

There is no doubt that there will be a great number of arrests and complaints before the courts, and as it will be for the people to know exactly what the law is, we therefore give the full text as follows.

Sec. 250. Every person who on the Christian Sabbath gets up, exhibits, opens or maintains, or aids in getting up, exhibiting, opening or maintaining any ball, race, cock or prize fight, horse race, sports, gambling house or saloon, or any business and amusements, or who keeps, conducts or exhibits any theatrical, musical, dance or other place of amusement, theatrical or athletic performance, sports, or representation where any wine, liquor, or intoxicating drinks are bought, sold, drunk, or given away, or who purchases any ticket of admission, or directly or indirectly pays any admission fee to or for the purpose of witnessing or attending any such place of amusement, theatrical, athletic performance or representation, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Sec. 251. Every person who keeps open on Sunday any place, such as bar, saloon, gambling house, or other place of business, for the purpose of transacting business therein in violation of the law, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Sec. 252. The provisions of the preceding sections do not apply to persons who, on Sunday, keep open hotels, boarding-houses, livery stables, livery, markets, restaurants, taverns, drug stores, or retail drug stores, for the legitimate business of such places, or who, in the legitimate business of such places, are usually kept in continued operation.
