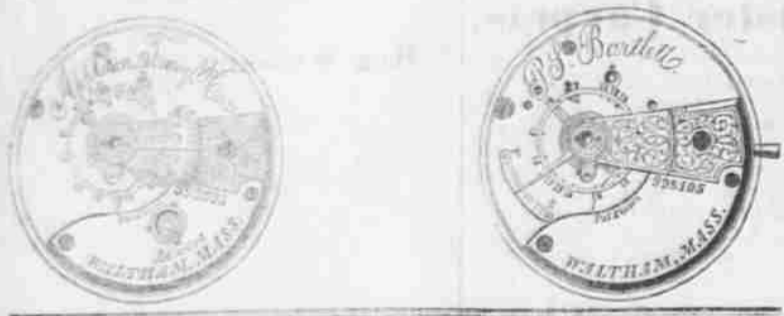

WE WALK BY FAITH. A SERMON PREACHED IN MARION SQUARE CHURCH, BY THE REV. DR. C. H. PARKHURST, D. D.

Text—2 Cor. v. 7. We walk by faith, said Paul, and we do not see things as they are.

Paul meant it in a particular sense. He was thinking of religion, the Lord, and the life to come.

It is true in a wider sense. We are walking by faith everywhere, and in all things.

Religion, the Lord, and immortality, are quite of a kind with other things, and so are ours to our apprehension of them, and the mode of becoming assured of them. I do not discover that there is any heavier drain of faith on the matter of religion than on other matters of thinking, living, and working.

We, all of us, in everything believe a great deal more than we know. We know that we know, and we do not say believers in Christ, believers in immortality, but believers. We are believers conditionally. Belief is about the first thing that shows itself in a man. As a rule, the knowledge we have is belief before it is knowledge.

It seems strange that men should find so much difficulty with the matter of religion in the gospel, seeing we are in such hourly familiarity with it on other ground. I have thought that perhaps the matter is not so simple as it is. A little relief might come to some of us if we are prejudiced against religion because it seems faith so heavily. We have got to deal with things which are not of this world, and which are not of the same nature as things which we see with our eyes.

Such of scientific discovery is only generalization of difficulty, as when Newton made gravity cover the phenomena of the sky as well as of the earth. We do not dissolve our ignorance by denying the matter we are ignorant of, by a Latinized nomenclature.
