Exmoor's newest festival is also perhaps the oddest. Starting from scratch in January, with no budget whatsoever, it has successfully run two weekends in May focussed on music making by local people. Enthusiasm has emerged for community choirs, music lessons and using All Saints church for get togethers. We aim to celebrate what ordinary local people can do, from music to embroidery, writing to carpentry.

July sees the first touring concert by the Culm Valley orchestra – our nearest community orchestra. This is followed by a weekend of opportunities to try out many


different forms of healing activities, from meditation to Reiki, from gong baths to creative writing for well-being. There are no charges. Practitioners are giving their services free in order to demonstrate the wide range of activities and help available to off-set the strains of modern life.





JULY CONCERTS IN LOCAL VINEYARD

After a couple of sell-out concerts in May and June, Wellhayes Vineyard continue their series of classical music concerts – *Music@Wellhayes* - with two concerts in July featuring outstanding young Artists. Wellhayes Vineyard produces quality English Sparkling Wine on the edge of Exmoor near Clayhanger, about 10 miles from Dulverton. The *Music@Wellhayes* concerts take place in a room above the winery overlooking the vineyard and provide an opportunity, in an unusual environment, to taste their sparkling wine and other products as well as English Wine by other local producers alongside enjoying the high-quality musical performances.



On Thursday 4th July exciting young pianist Clare Hammond will perform a programme which includes Rachmaninov, Debussy and Schumann. Clare won the Royal Philharmonic Society's "Young Artist Award" for outstanding achievement in 2016 and has been widely praised for her playing, including by the Telegraph which described her as a pianist of "amazing power and panache".

The following week, on Saturday 13th July, the Janus Ensemble return to perform a programme that includes

Schumann's Piano Quintet. Described as "a terrific group of young, talented, enthusiastic players whose musicianship is exemplary", the Group was founded in 2015, and this will be the third successive year that they have performed as part of the *Music@Wellhayes* series.







Friday 5th July 2019 1.00pm – 3.00pm Hawkcombe Butterfly Walk

A walk to look at some of the coppice management work being done in this National Nature Reserve to help the recovery of the heath fritillary butterfly. A spectacular circling walk starting in picturesque Bossington, via the dramatic cliffs at Hurlstone Point, continuing around the sweeping shingle ridge and across the saltmarsh. The walk will provide lots of opportunities for discovering coastal and marine wildlife, historic landscape features and the changing features of this nationally important coastline. No dogs. Residents and visitors alike love the patchwork of fields and open spaces which make walking on Exmoor such a pleasure. Livestock graze on both private and common land, and all belong to someone. Imagine how distressing it is to go out one lovely May morning and find that one of your young fit ewes has been killed by dogs a few hours earlier. The details are gruesome, so we'll omit them here.

DOGS AND SHEEP

When dogs are out of control they enjoy a chase. Two or more dogs will act co-operatively as a pack and a ewe defending her offspring is no match for them. The only defence a sheep has is flight, but under these circumstances they are paralysed by fear.

If you should witness negligent behaviour by a dog owner, please try to explain the possible consequences. Nobody wants to shoot a pet dog, but if it is caught red-handed committing the crime of sheep worrying then that is the risk. Dogs driving sheep over a cliff are equally guilty.


