4-H Member Goal Setting = 4-H Member Success

“A goal without a plan is just a wish.” - Antoine de Saint-Exupery.

Achieving goals is satisfying and builds confidence. By setting goals and being accountable at the end of each 4-H year, you can realistically know what to expect from yourself and what you can achieve.

1. Set small goals - write them down
2. Set a timeline for achieving each goal
3. Make a plan for how you will meet your goals
4. Schedule a time when you will work on your plan/goals
5. Decide on milestones toward meeting your goals.
6. Periodically review your progress to hold your self accountable.
7. Celebrate when you achieve your goals or reflect on why not.

Example goals: I want to learn how to keep my market lambs healthy; learn the body parts of my rabbit; learn how to make pies; learn to use the features of my sewing machine; how to properly use your digital camera; add to my 4-H Career Portfolio each month; take time to read the Newsletter & emails; or make an effort to meet all deadlines as required.

The Nebraska 4-H Diamond Clover program encourages 4-H youth to engage in a variety of projects and activities that will enable members to acquire the life skills necessary to lead successful lives as a competent, caring, and contributing citizen. The Diamond Clover Program is designed for all ages of 4-H members.

The program consists of six levels that require a 4-H member to plan and report a broad range of age-appropriate accomplishments. New 4-H Foods & Food Preservation Manuals

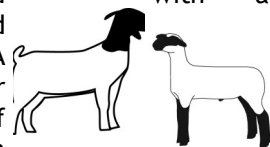

We will also be adding Home Food Preservation manuals for Freezing, Drying, Boiling Water Canning, and Pressure Canning. Market Sheep/Meat Goat Tag/ID Day

We are offering a tagging day on **Thursday, May 31 2018, 4-7 p.m.** at the fairgrounds in Crete for all market lambs/market meat goats to be eligible for the Rate of Gain contests. It is no longer mandatory that Extension staff complete the tagging and DNA.

Market sheep and goats exhibited at State Fair or Ak-Sar-Ben need to be nominated with a DNA sample and EID tag (4-H and FFA use the same EID tag). DNA samples will be taken this day or you may pull your own sample if you do not wish to be included in the Rate of Gain contests. Cost of the DNA is \$6.00 per animal. County Fair Ear tags will cost \$1.00 and EID tags will cost \$2. If completing your own DNA envelopes, these **MUST** be at the Extension Office no later than JUNE 15th with online nomination complete by midnight, June 15th using www.showstockmgr.com.



NEW MANDATORY Market Swine Tag/ID Day

New in 2018, the official ID will be EID tags for all market swine for County Fair, State Fair & Ak-Sar-Ben. Ear notches may be recorded as an additional form of ID but will not serve as the official form of identification. Based on decisions made at the Fall Livestock Advisory Meetings, all swine exhibitors will need to bring their swine to the tagging day Thursday, May 31 2018, 4-7 p.m. at the fairgrounds in Crete for staff to verify tagging. Families will tag their own swine to avoid disease with staff verifying. If you cannot attend, you will need to set up a time with Eric or Randy to bring your pigs to the Extension Office to verify tagging by June 8th. All tagging must be witnessed by Extension staff. Lottery Pigs will NOT need to come to the tagging day.



Market swine to be exhibited at State Fair or Ak-Sar-Ben need to be nominated with a DNA sample and EID tag (4-H and FFA use the same EID tag). DNA samples will be taken this day or you may pull your own sample. The DNA is \$6.00 per animal. EID tags will cost \$2. If completing your own DNA envelopes, these **MUST** be at the Extension Office no later than JUNE 15th with online nomination complete by midnight, June 15th using www.showstockmgr.com. Late DNA samples will not be accepted and are not eligible for State Fair or Ak-Sar-Ben competition.

* Fair Book Animal Class Changes *

Based on recommendations of those in attendance at the Livestock Advisory Committee meetings the following changes will be implemented for 2018.

BEEF:

ADDED: Maintainer Breeding Heifer Classes
Shorthorn Breeding Heifer Classes - Does not include Shorthorn Plus

All registered breeding heifers - Registration papers will need to meet specific breed percentages as listed in the fairbook. The percentages are the same as State Fair requires to show in a breed class.

DELETED: Pen of 3 breeding beef, Pen of 3 market beef and Pen of 3 feeder calves.

GOAT:

IDENTIFICATION: Scrapie Tags for Market & Breeding

ADDED: Lottery Goat if interest warrants

DELETED: Mother-Offspring Class

Tagging and weigh day is **STRONGLY ENCOURAGED**.

SHEEP:

IDENTIFICATION: Scrapie Tags for Market & Breeding

DELETED: Pen of 2 breeding lambs & Pen of 2 Market Lambs

Tagging and weigh day is **STRONGLY ENCOURAGED**.

SWINE:

IDENTIFICATION: Official Identification is **EID tags** instead of notches.

All swine will be tagged at a tagging day or come by the office for verification of tagging.

Paylean use allowed, but does limit our marketing options.

HORSE:

CHANGE: Name change—Ranch Horse Pleasure will now be titled Ranch Riding. This is a pattern class.

ADDED: High Point Pony

POULTRY:

ADDED: Egg Class

Youth for Quality Care of Animals Certification

All youth ages 8-18 and FFA exhibitors MUST complete Youth for the Quality Care of Animals (YQCA) certification by **June 15th** to be eligible to exhibit beef, sheep, goats, swine, rabbits, and poultry at the County Fair, State Fair, & Ak-Sar-Ben.

Youth have three options this year: the online course, Face to Face training or test out (Intermediate & Senior age youth ONLY).

Intermediate (ages 11-14) and Senior (ages 15-18 or older (FFA)) age youth can also take the written test to test out. We recommend you study before coming in to test. Practice tests are available on the current LQA site. Please call before coming in to test.

You will receive a certificate of completion for either method. (Print the certificates and we will give you credit when you bring them in.) **CREDIT IS NOT GIVEN UNTIL WE HAVE THE CERTIFICATE!** No certificate = no certification! The certificate is our record of your completion.

Horse Levels Testing

Now would be a great time to begin working on your first advancement level or your next level. Written tests, club demonstrations, written reports, feed charts, and health care papers can all be done now so as Spring approaches you can complete your riding skills tests.

In order to compete at the county fair, 4-H'ers must have completed level 1. District and state horse show participants must pass level 2 or higher for some events prior to submitting entries. Riding tests can only be administered by a certified examiner. Advancement levels information can be found at: <http://4h.unl.edu/horse/advancement>. Call our office if you have any questions.

District Horse Show

June 14 has been set for the District Horse show in York. Youth ages 10 & older as of Jan. 1st are eligible providing that they have completed the required levels testing. To be eligible, youth must have passed Level 2 of the Horse Advancement Levels by time of entry.

Entries are due to the Extension Office by May 11th.

Premise ID Requirements for 2018

Exhibitors of 4-H and FFA market beef, goats, sheep, and swine that carry an EID tag **will be required** to submit a Premise ID number obtained through the Nebraska Department of Agriculture at no cost to the exhibitor. Exhibitors **will not be allowed** to exhibit at the Nebraska State Fair without a Premise ID being supplied to the Extension Office.



The Premise ID should be obtained for the physical location of where the animals are located and housed. If the animals are housed in multiple locations, a Premise ID must be obtained for each location.

The same Premise ID(s) will apply to more than one youth if there are multiple exhibitors housing livestock at the same location. No need to apply for a Premise ID for each youth family member.

If you received a Premise ID previously, you can verify a Premise ID by calling 402-471-2351.

NEW PROCEDURES FOR NOMINATING MARKET AND BREEDING ANIMALS FOR STATE FAIR AND AK-SAR-BEN IN 2018

Family Responsibilities: FAMILY MUST NOW COMPLETE NOMINATION & PAY FOR DNA ONLINE

1. Exhibitors showing market animals at State Fair or AKSARBEN must have a signed and sealed official DNA hair samples for verification turned into our office by deadlines (Apr. 15 Mkt Beef; June 15 Mkt sheep, goats, and swine). **NEW:** complete online nominations using the (www.showstockmgr.com) site along with submitting payment for DNA online by the deadline listed in the table in this issue.
2. Any animal carrying an 840 EID tag will require the exhibitor to obtain a **Premises ID and on file at Ext. Office by May 1**. Details in above article.
3. Exhibitors showing breeding beef, breeding sheep and breeding does at State Fair or AKSARBEN will need to complete an online nomination (www.showstockmgr.com) by the June 15 deadline. There is no nomination fee for breeding animals for State Fair or Ak-Sar-Ben.
4. Bring breed registration papers to check-in for breed class verification.





4-H (ages 8-18) and FFA exhibitors of beef, goats, sheep, swine, rabbit and poultry must complete quality assurance training through YQCA (Youth for the Quality Care of Animals) **by June 15, 2018** to be eligible to exhibit at the County Fair, State Fair or Ak-Sar-Ben.

Clover Kids ages 5-7 DO NOT need to complete quality assurance training.

LATE FEE POLICY REMINDER

As we move closer to county fair we wanted to remind you of the "Late Fee" policy. Deadlines are set to allow our office time to process and send in your animal identifications, fair entries, etc. so you meet the required deadline. Prompt and accurate fair entries are needed to allow us time to generate reports, show programs, entry cards, etc. All of these take a lot of time or need to be reprocessed/formatted for late entries.



The 4-H Council late fee policy is \$10 per member for those late with Identification paperwork, and county fair entries. Identification forms and or entries may be submitted up to 5 days past the specified deadline (County Fair only) and late fee will apply. **ID PAPERWORK AND COUNTY FAIR ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AFTER THIS 5 DAY PERIOD! If you are late with State Fair or Ak-Sar-Ben animal nominations or entries you are ineligible.**

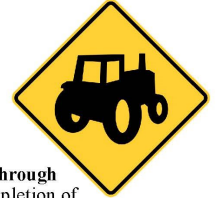

Tractor Safety Training 2018



All youth aged 14 and 15 and working on a farm or ranch other than their own *MUST* be certified through a Hazardous Occupations Course. Successful completion of the course will allow trained youth to operate a tractor over 20 horsepower, or to connect or disconnect an implement or any of its parts to or from a tractor.

Livestock Identification For 2018

Read carefully as there are changes!

Market animals: 4-H & FFA will be using EID tags and DNA for all market beef and market swine exhibited at the State Fair and Ak-Sar-Ben. **NEW-County Fair Market Swine** will use EID tags as the official identification method. Ear notches may be recorded but WILL NOT serve as the primary identification method. The cost of the EID tag will be \$2 per tag. The cost of DNA samples will be \$6 per DNA sample paid online. You will need to pick up the DNA sample envelopes and tags from our office. DNA MUST be returned by April 15 (Mkt. Beef) and June 15 for all other market animals.



Breeding animals: Animals exhibited at the County Fair, State Fair and/or Ak-Sar-Ben will need to have a Breeding nomination card completed and on file at the Extension Office by **June 15th**. Breeding heifers will require a tattoo (4-H & FFA).

NEW—Market & Breeding sheep and goats will use a Scrapie tag as the official identification method for commercial animals. Purebred breeding sheep & goats will need a Scrapie tag & number matching registration papers (herd tag or tattoo).
