Harkness Win A Gold Medal At Chelsea Flower Show 2021



Harkness Roses has been awarded the Royal Horticultural Society's prestigious gold medal for its display at the Chelsea Flower Show this week. Throughout the company's 140-year history, Harkness have won more than 25 Gold Medals at Chelsea and are over the moon to add another to their collection.

When scoring the stand, the RHS judges look at the overall impact and design of the stand, the quality and health of the plants and the level of difficulty in creating the display.

Director David White said: "Our roses are incredibly disease resistant and their ability to keep flowering into the Autumn really does give them the wow factor. All the hard work that went into getting the roses ready for September has clearly paid off and we beyond proud of our gold medal achievement. Our show stand is a credit to all the team and nursery staff who grow the roses".

New Introductions For 2021



Every year we introduce new varieties from our extensive breeding and research programme. It takes seven or eight years to breed and test a new variety. We only introduce those that we believe to be worthy of a place in our listing and our customers gardens.

It is a long-held belief at Harkness that our environment is important, that we value nature, work with nature and respect nature. I remember in the late 1960s a conversation with my late father, Jack Harkness, about the use of insecticides to control insects on the nursery. He was adamant that if we have greenfly we should only use a narrow spectrum insecticide, one that will not harm the beneficial insects like bees and lacewings. He was not interested and wouldn't authorise use of a general insecticide, which may have been more effective and may have been more economical. He valued the wellbeing of our environment more highly than either cost or expediency. This was a rare attitude in the 1960s, a view way ahead of its time, and one which we still adhere to now.

In 1994 we went a step further and ceased use of any fungicides in our breeding programme. All the trials we carry out on new roses are in a hostile environment for the plants, where we give no protection from disease. Only the most robust rose varieties will flourish and make it through our rigorous regime.

John Ystumllyn Rose



John Ystumllyn rose, a brand new rose variety, and is the first ever rose to be named after an ethnic minority Briton.

John Ystumllyn was an 18th century gardener who was the first well-recorded Black person in North Wales and with his marriage to Margaret Gruffydd, part of the first interracial marriage in Wales. We wanted to breed a new rose as a symbol of friendship, love and community and to bring people together after the divisiveness of recent years. We also wanted to inspire people from all backgrounds to see gardening as a career or activity for them.

We wanted to create a rose that does justice to the story of John Ystumllyn and that anybody in the country could easily grow, whether in a garden or in a pot on the patio. The John Ystumllyn Rose is a Hybrid Tea. It grows to 80cm tall and 60 cm wide. The flower itself is a beautiful golden yellow variety that doesn't fade, it starts flowering early and goes on to the first frosts and has a lovely scent to it. We chose yellow because it conveys warmth and is associated with friendship. Even if some people do not garden themselves, we hope this rose will brighten up homes".

We and We Too Built Britain want gardening to be for all and have set aside 5000 roses for community gardens and will send out roses for free to community garden groups.

The John Ystumylln rose has an uncomplicated colour, a refreshing yellow which hardly fades at all. The plant is good looking, bushy with even growth that is densely covered with glossy dark green leaves. Starting to flower, early the buds open into double old fashioned style blooms, up to 12cm wide, they sit proudly above the dark leaf. With a long flowering season, this is a valuable plant in the garden. Use in beds, borders or low hedges.

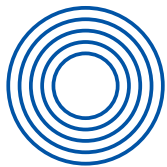

Bush Roses



Bush roses are indispensable in any modern garden. There are a vast range of Bush Roses, but here we concentrate on our selection that we believe will give gardeners most pleasure.

In old fashioned traditional terms, a bush rose is either a Hybrid Tea rose which usually have only one flower per stem and tend to flower in three flushes from summer to late autumn. Floribunda roses have many flowers per stem and tend to repeat-flower continuously from summer to late autumn.



Amber Queen ☆☆☆☆

Floribunda Rose (Harmony)

🕒 Medium Fragrance 📏 H 75cm x W 65cm

The popularity of Amber Queen is enduring. First and foremost, it is a very pretty flower, the colour is a pure golden amber, the shape is rounded and there are plenty of petals. We always enjoy the perfume which is an uncomplicated sweet rose. Then there is the plant. It is a short bushy plant that has wonderful decorative bronze to red young foliage, turning dark green. Quick to repeat flower, this is perfect in beds, borders or large patio pots.



Belmonte ☆☆☆☆

Floribunda Rose (Harpearl)

A truly delicate soft shell pink flower which will consistently have wonderful form and structure, with strong petals creating a pointed bud before the flower opens.
