President's & Director's Report

With this report, we wish to celebrate our achievements of the past 12 months, congratulate those who worked hard to help reach our goals and to express our gratitude to the many generous donors whose gifts make so much possible.

It has always been our belief that the visual arts promote understanding and tolerance of multicultural concepts and historical perspectives by educating people about the art and history of other times and places in the world. Through exposure to authentic works of art, artists, curators and educators, we provide our community an opportunity to learn about and understand that there are cultures and customs in the world different from their own. By making art available, approachable, and accessible to all through exhibitions and a broad range of activities and interpretive programs, the FIA provides multiple ways of exploring the world's most inspiring human expressions.

Having just completed the third year of our current five-year strategic plan, we are pleased to report that we made significant progress over the last 12 months in pursuit of the plan's goals to 1.) Develop sustainable income, 2.) Increase audiences, 3.) Maintain the public trust, and 4.) Seek technological advantages in all aspects of operations.

The FIA's goal—to develop sustainable income—includes raising funds for programs and operations annually, as well as raising endowment funds to ensure the long-term financial health of the FIA. 2014 was an especially good year because of the support we received from so many community donors including: the Charles Stewart Mott Foundation who contributed to all areas of our operation; our two auxiliary groups—the Friends of Modern Art and the Founders Society for supporting exhibitions, collections, and the film program; sponsorship of Free Saturdays by FirstMerit Bank; corporate sponsorship of the film program from Merrill Lynch and Guardian Alarm; exhibition sponsorship by the Whiting Foundation and the Community Foundation of Greater Flint; support of the College Town program came from the Miner Trust; the Welch Foundation supported the Pre College Portfolio Development program; we received general operating support from Michigan Council for Arts and Cultural Affairs; the Nartel Family Foundation and Merklely Elderly Trust focused on senior programs; the Sheppy Dog Fund again supported its annual lecture and,

this year, increased support to include educational programs; PNC Bank, Target, and Ruth Mott Foundation sponsored early childhood education programs; and the Isabel Foundation, A.G. Bishop Trust, Ms. Susie Thompson, Michigan Council for Arts and Cultural Affairs, Beth Howarth Estate, and Runyan Pottery Supply contributed to the Art School renovations and equipment.

Notable individual contributions this year came from: Mr. and Mrs. Jay Nelson, Mrs. Claire White, Mrs. Nancy Kleinpell, Ms. Lynne Hurand, Mrs. Doris Sutton, Mr. Durfee Day, Mrs. Eleanor Brownell, Dr. Alex Chan, Dr. Jamille Trueba Lewand, Ms. Barnie Bishop, and Ms. Grayce Scholt who personally supported the Annual Appeal, scholarships, collections, exhibitions, capital projects, upgraded lighting, equipment, and accessibility improvements.

Our four annual events, Art On Tap, the Community Gala, Wine Tasting and The Party, collectively had 189 sponsors and 1,415 attendees with Applebee's and Tropi Tan as new signature sponsors. Our "Raise the Roof" campaign for roof replacement was also very successful with 91 contributions from individual members, a significant grant from Michigan Council for Arts and Cultural Affairs, and a Board of Trustees challenge. In addition, 63 organizations, businesses and individuals rented the facility entertaining 5,059 guests.

This year, we were pleased to announce the conclusion of a quiet \$10 million Endowment Campaign that began immediately following the renovation and expansion in 2005-06 to support general operating needs resulting from the expansion. We then introduced a new three-phased \$9 million Endowment Campaign called 4, 3, 2 Endowment which will focus on three areas in need of sustainability with goals of \$4 million for Art School operations, \$3 million for collections and exhibitions, and \$2 million for museum operations.

Capital projects this year included the expansion to the Art School totaling \$498,930. The nearly 1,500 square feet expansion to the southwest corner of the building added the welding lab and new support areas for the ceramics program including a glaze mixing lab and raw material storage. Reconfigured spaces in the kiln area and a new, energy efficient Bailey kiln have doubled the capacity of the ceramics program.

Also this year, we improved accessibility with

automatic door openers for the gallery restrooms and new automatic sliding doors for the lobby entrance. We are especially pleased with the progress of our energy conservation efforts. This year, 166 incandescent light bulbs were replaced with LED. When this project is complete we will accomplish a savings of \$12,500 annually from the reduction of nearly 190,000 KWH each year. The longer-life bulbs will also save an additional \$2,000–\$4,000 in replacement costs.

Other noteworthy achievements in 2014 include offering 211 art classes with an enrollment of 1,423; providing educational programs that served 39,587 people; and, attendance of 125,186 through May 31st. Membership reached 2,280 representing 3,179 individuals this year, not counting an additional 1,186 College Town members.

The FIA is always developing new and dynamic ways to connect people with the visual arts. The greatest audience development and diversification opportunity of our time unquestionably lies in our ability to utilize the internet and mobile technologies as programming tools. Nearly half a million people have accessed the FIA website, blog, and social networking pages this year. The flexibility of digital media and the ease of making it available in multiple formats provides the greatest access to the multitude of concepts in our galleries. New technologies are making it possible for: experts from across the country to participate in FIA programs without traveling to Flint; visually

impaired people to use a computer to enlarge an image or listen to an audio commentary; hearing-impaired people who rely on text and images to experience art; people in our community who are functionally illiterate and rely on audio content to enhance the museum experience; and visitors who simply want to learn more about an object.

Equally dedicated to the contemporary artistic mediums of today, as it is to the historically significant objects in the collection, the FIA presented 25 exhibitions and installed 786 works. 75 artworks were added to our permanent collection, seven works were lent to other museums, and 120 works—rarely or never before on view—were installed throughout the permanent collection galleries.

Exhibitions

Exhibitions are the most visible programming activities at the Flint Institute of Arts and stimulate greater audience visitation. The FIA strives to curate and host a variety of exhibitions to meet the museum's mission of promoting understanding and appreciation of art for all. In total, this year visitors had the opportunity to see almost 500 works of art, many of which were drawn from the FIA's permanent collection, including decorative arts, paintings, works on paper, and sculpture, all from various cultures and time periods. With the FIA being the only institution of its kind in Flint, Genesee County, and the region north of the Detroit metropolitan area, it is vital that exhibitions explore a wide range of artistic concepts from around the world. Art featured in the exhibitions held this year ranged in media from traditional paintings to contemporary mixed media works that included neon, fire hoses, televisions, and even a basketball backboard and hoop. As much as the media varied, so did the histories and stories surrounding the works, appealing to and allowing us to reach a broader audience than ever before.

In the summer, *Modern Dialect: American Paintings from the John and Susan Horseman Collection* told the story of America between the two World Wars through paintings that celebrated and sometimes even exposed, harsh realities in the United States. Michael D. Hall presented on the topic of art between the Wars in a lecture titled "The American Scene as an Artist Collaborative." Simultaneously, *Science in Motion: The Photographic Studies of Muybridge, Abbott, and Edgerton* was a photography exhibition held in the FIA's Graphics Gallery that showcased technological advancements in photography. Bank of America sponsored this exhibition through their Art in Our Communities Program.

One hundred and thirty works by Henri de Toulouse-Lautrec were featured in *Toulouse-Lautrec and His World*. A standing room only crowd attended the opening lecture by Dr. Nancy Ireson titled "Toulouse-Lautrec: From the Street to the Museum." This exhibition from the Herakleidon Museum in Athens, Greece, featured works on paper including drawings and lithographs, that were often playful or satirical, capturing the essence of the subject.

From January through April, the FIA hosted two exhibitions featuring contemporary African

American art. Works on paper by local artist Lavarne Ross captured the city of Flint and its people over the artist's lifetime. At the same time, *Point of View: Contemporary African American Art from the Elliot & Kimberly Perry Collection* was on view in our Hodge and Temporary Exhibition Galleries. Former NBA player and now coach, Elliot Perry and his wife Kimberly have amassed a large collection of African American art. The FIA worked in collaboration with the Charles H. Wright Museum of African American History in Detroit to bring the works to Michigan and co-publish a catalogue. While the Wright Museum displayed the master works, the FIA showcased the contemporary works from the Perry Collection. The resulting publication was titled *Point of View: African American Art from the Elliot and*

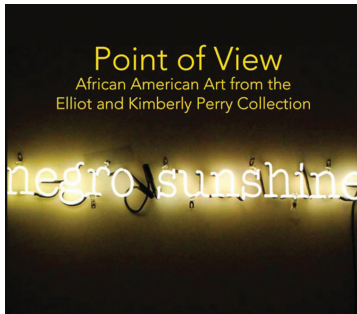

Kimberly Perry Collection. Essays by Jacqueline Francis and Erica Moiah James told a compelling history of how African American art has changed over time and what



it means to be an African American artist in today's world. At the Community Gala, Mr. Perry gave a tour of his work on display followed by a lecture by Ms. James.

In the spring, the FIA opened three major exhibitions. *About Face:*

Portraiture Through Time was curated from the FIA's permanent collection and examined key elements from portraiture's rich history from the 17th century to present day. Tracee Glab, FIA's Curator of Collections and Exhibitions, presented at the exhibition opening a lecture titled "At Face Value: The Nature of Portraiture." *Kathleen Gilje: Portraits of Paintings* examined the work of contemporary artist Kathleen Gilje. Gilje is known for her "restorations" in which she takes an Old Master painting and puts a new twist on it, sometimes referencing social issues of today or replacing subjects in the works with art historians, critics, other artists, or even herself. During the week of the opening, Gilje was the FIA's special guest and worked with students in the Art School. The third exhibition, *Fantasy, Fiction, and Fact in Popular Illustration: 1750–1900*, was guest curated by Sarah Lippert, Associate Professor at the University of Michigan–Flint. In conjunction with the exhibition, Lippert published a catalogue by the same title.

While some of the exhibitions had serious undertones, other exhibitions like *Walk on the Wild Side: Animals and Other Creatures in Art* and *Beatrice Wood: Mama of Dada* had whimsical and fun themes. *Walk on the Wild Side* featured works from the FIA's permanent collection that dealt with the subject of animals in art over thousands of years, while *Mama of Dada* explored works on paper by Beatrice Wood, which documented many humorous scenes throughout the artist's life. Dada expert and longtime friend of Wood, Francis Naumann, lectured on Wood, her art, and her life.

In this fiscal year, Hodge Galleries attendance totaled 17,622.

Videos

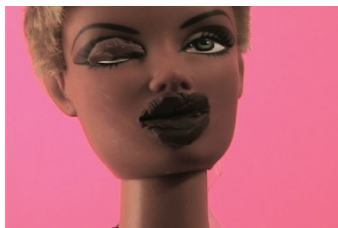

Films

The FIA Film Program is intended to offer motion pictures that appeal to a broad and diverse audience in the local community. The program is comprised of a weekly schedule of film series and festivals in the FIA Theater. The main series, sponsored by the Friends of Modern Art and held on Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays, accounted for 49 titles over 40 weeks from September until June in 2013-14.

A total of 9,005 patrons—the fourth-highest yearly total ever—attended films at the FIA in 2013-14. In addition, the FIA Film Society continued for its fifth year to enable members to take a stronger interest in the program.

Among the films shown at the FIA in 2013-14 were *The Great Beauty*, the 2013 Academy Award winner for Best Foreign Language Film; *20 Feet From Stardom*, which won the 2013 Academy Award for Best Documentary; the Oscar-winning Woody Allen comedy *Blue Jasmine*; and the India-set comedy-drama *The Lunchbox*, which was the season's most popular attraction in terms of attendance.

A Thursday night "Best of FOMA" film series supplemented the weekend series, providing viewers the opportunity to see classic art films or return looks at titles shown at the FIA in recent years.

A new digital projection system was installed in the FIA Theater at the start of the movie season in September. A significant upgrade to the sound system was made later in the fall. Both projects greatly enhanced the viewing experience in the theater.

In partnership with Flint’s Arab American Heritage Council, the Oscar-winning Arabic-themed documentary *5 Broken Cameras* was shown at the museum in an event that also included an art exhibition and live dance performances. 80 people attended.

May 4–8

Karen Schneider Jewish Film Festival of Flint

In the 10th annual local festival—a spinoff of the Detroit-based Lenore Marwil Jewish Film Festival—four feature-length films and two short films were shown in a co-sponsorship with the Flint Jewish Federation. The films screened were *The Sturgeon Queens*, *Aya*, *The Third Half*, *Lost Town*, *The Attack*, and *Quality Balls: The David Steinberg Story*. During preview events, the movies *Blumenthal* and *The Upside-Down Book* were shown. A total of 535 people attended.

Film Society

The 2013–14 season marked the fifth year of the FIA Film Society, a group devoted to increasing interest in, and funding for, the film program.

By season’s end, the society included 71 members and sponsors. Most of them were at the basic membership level of \$100, which granted the donor 36 tickets to FOMA films, listings in the FIA Magazine and Annual Report, and access to a monthly e-mailed newsletter about upcoming movies.

Higher sponsorship levels gained donors listings on screen before each film presentation, extra tickets and a presence on the FIA website.

Art School

The FIA Art School is dedicated to the enrichment of the community through individual academic exposure to the visual arts. Highly qualified faculty offer instruction in ceramics, drawing, painting, photography, digital arts, animation, fibers, glass mosaic, sculpture, and early childhood art courses. Since 1928, the Art School has operated continuously, helping students develop a wide range of artistic goals and skill levels. Programs are designed to support the mission of the FIA with dynamic curricula that engages students and the community through creative processes, studio experiences, and gallery exhibitions.

Programming

The FIA collaborative *Healing Through Art Therapy* program with McLaren Flint generated 95 encounters during the 2013-2014 fiscal year with art therapist Gail Singer. The Art School continued its collaboration with the Food Bank of Eastern Michigan and produced 1,500 bowls for the Food Bank's annual *Empty Bowls Project* in September of 2013. The Art School offered five Studio Soiree painting workshops for a total of 77 enrollees who participated in one-night, hands-on studio experiences complete with refreshments. The Art School continued to increase workshop opportunities for students and artists, and offered 31 workshops in various mediums including; matting and framing, drawing, painting, fibers, and ceramic. The *Pre-College Portfolio Development Program*, in its sixth year, continued to offer gifted local high school visual arts students (26) opportunities to enhance specific skill sets designed to create a visual arts portfolio for college entrance and/or performance based scholarships.

Student Amenities

The Bishop Gallery, in its final year of a three-year grant from the Bishop Charitable Trust, converted all track lighting from traditional incandescent bulbs to new energy efficient LED lights on the first and second floor corridors. In June 2013, construction began on a 1,500 square foot expansion and enhancement which included a glaze lab with spray booth and adequate storage for the calculating/mixing of clay and glaze, as well as, a pug-mill for the reclaiming of clay; new welding studio with three additional MIG welders and stations, metal shear, metal stretcher, and English wheel; additional operating space for kilns and clay storage; and a new 54 cubic feet fully automatic Bailey natural gas downdraft shuttle kiln. The added and renovated spaces maximized existing space use; installed energy-efficient, accessible equipment; addressed and corrected minor obstacles that hindered accessibility and work flow; eliminated safety hazards; and increased functionality of spaces. The new kiln area and glaze lab doubled the capacity of the ceramics program raw material storage, kiln room, and glaze mixing area, and provided opportunities for added ceramics courses and student production. Benefits include the firing of larger works, financial savings with regard to fuel consumption and less firings, and offer new opportunities for course offerings such as glaze calculation and preparation and kiln firing methods. New studio space for the welding and fabrication lab increased the Art School's ability to offer instruction on the visual and physical properties of metal and various techniques in welding and light metal fabrication. Additions to the Art School reflect the interior and exterior design aesthetic of architect Frederick Fisher & Partners. Local architect, John K. Costa provided on-site architectural services throughout the building process and local contractor, Sorensen Gross Construction Services managed the construction. The Art School Renovation/Equipment Fund had 98 donors raising \$498,930.

The Art School granted \$16,375 in scholarships for the 2013-14 FY to 124 students (85 youth scholarships and 39 adult scholarships).

Education

The Flint Institute of Arts is committed to promoting understanding and enjoyment of the visual arts through high quality art education programs. Believing that art is a vital component of life and that learning is a lifelong process, its educational programming provides dynamic and enriching experiences for people of all ages and with all levels of familiarity with art.

FIA programs invite people to gain greater understanding and enjoyment of the FIA's outstanding permanent collection and special exhibitions. They are designed to present learning opportunities that are rich in content and stimulate imagination, thought and creativity.

Education programs served a total of 45,797 during the fiscal year.

K-12 Programs

Gallery and studio programs comprised 54% of educational programming and served 26,332 K-12 and homeschool students. Twenty-nine percent participated in gallery lessons, 25% in studio activities, 45% in outreach programs, and 1% in self-guided visits/other. Fifty-nine percent of students attended public schools, 25% private schools, and 16% homeschool/charter schools. The majority (87%) of schools served by the FIA's K-12 programs were from Genesee County, however, schools from Oakland, Lapeer, Livingston, St. Joseph, Wayne, St. Clair, Saginaw, and Midland counties were also served.

Public Programs

Consistent marketing through social media, mail, and email marketing kept attendance strong. Public programs served 19,465 people during FY2014, a gain of 4% over FY2013.

Docent Program

Docents are integral to the Education department. Twenty volunteers were involved in the docent program in FY2014. They participated in intensive training sessions from September through May. Docents assisted with 588 gallery and studio programs and served 8,179 people, resulting in 1,043 hours of service.

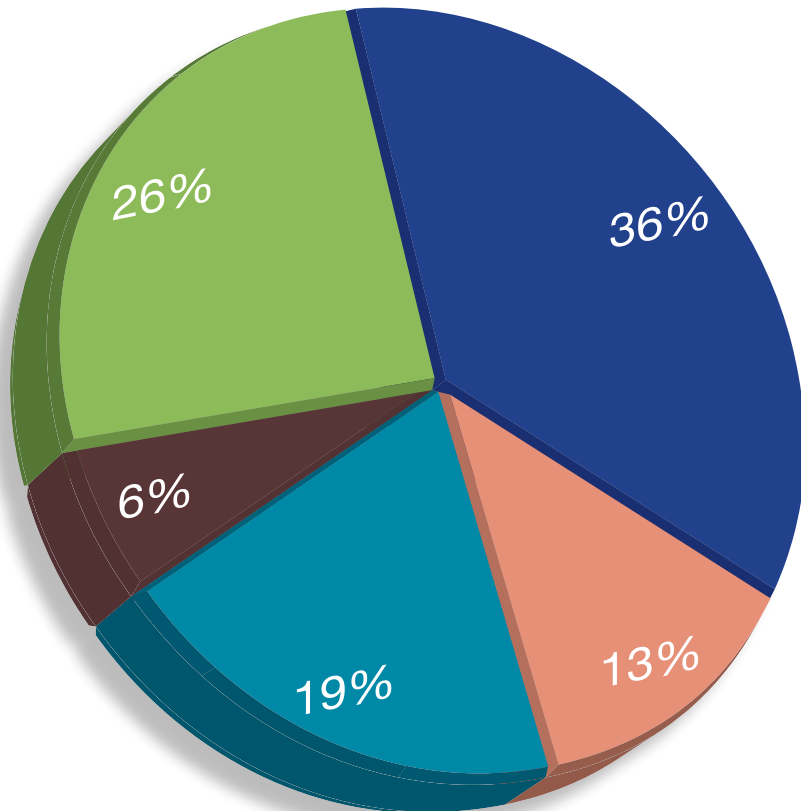
Development

The Development Department is responsible for all areas of funding for the FIA. This includes support through endowment growth, grants, earned income, contributions, and membership.

In addition, the department manages audience development, collaborative initiatives, facilities use, marketing, special events, social media and the website. The department also organizes a broad and diverse volunteer base.

Income

The FIA has five primary sources of support: endowment income, grants, earned income, contributions, and membership.

Endowment Income

Both restricted and unrestricted, endowment funds support general operations, exhibitions, programs, art acquisition, art conservation, scholarships, lectures, and membership initiatives. As of June 30, 2014 the endowment funds totaled \$30,255,861 contributing 26% of the annual income. Unrestricted donations in the form of planned gifts and bequests are traditionally allocated to endowment. Please see pages 24 for this fiscal year's listing.

Grants

The FIA receives grant awards from foundations, community organizations, businesses, corporations and the state and federal governments. Revenue from grants represents 36% of the FIA's annual income. The FIA receives support from two auxiliary groups, the Founders Society and Friends of Modern Art.

Earned Income

Income generated from sales, tuition, facility rentals, special events, and admissions provided 13% of the FIA's operating income.

Contributions

Sponsorships, annual appeal gifts, memorials, donations commemorating anniversaries and birthdays, and funding of specific programs or events, represents 19% of the FIA's annual income.

Membership

Membership dues represent 6% of the FIA's annual income. Membership levels begin at \$20 annually for a Youth (ages 2.5–12) or a student (ages 13+) and progresses to \$1,000+ annually for a Rubens membership. Basic benefits are enjoyed by all, and higher level donors receive extended benefits (such as reciprocal membership privileges to over 650 museums nationwide) at the Sustainer level (\$100) and above. The Rubens Society generates more than \$100,000 to the budget and Society members are invited to three exclusive events throughout the year. The FIA's Art school members receive a discount on art classes. Of new members who joined the FIA, 28.5% joined through the Art school.

The Flint Print Club was established in 2007. The club is limited to 100 members who, after first becoming a member of the FIA at the Family level (\$50) or above, receive a commissioned print by a noteworthy artist. The club is dedicated to the connoisseurship, the pursuit of personal collecting, and the purchase of prints to augment the FIA's collection.

The FIA College town initiative provides free memberships to students at Kettering University, University of Michigan-Flint, Mott Community College, and Baker College. Students receive many of the basic benefits and receive invitations and other announcements.

Letter from the President, Mike Wright

2013 was another busy and productive year for the Friends of Modern Art. Last fall the FOMA Film Series premiered on a brand new, state-of-the-art digital projection system that was funded by FOMA, along with significant contributions from FIA Film Society donors. The upgrade was necessary due to the aging 35mm projectors (which were another past FOMA purchase) and the shift in the preferred delivery and presentation formats for modern-day films.

Direct support for FIA museum activities were not limited to just the projector purchase. In the spring of 2014, FOMA contributed \$25,000 towards the funding of the exhibition *Kathleen Gilje: Portraits of Paintings*. This show featured the work of the renowned artist Kathleen Gilje and her reinterpretations, or 'remixing', of classical pieces of artwork by famous European old masters. FOMA also purchased two prints at the annual FIA Print Fair, which were gifted to the museum.

In June, the Friends of Modern Art presented the 47th annual Flint Art Fair on the grounds of the Flint Institute of Arts. The Art Fair is an event that has become ingrained in the collective cultural experience of local residents as well as out-of-town visitors. This year, thanks entirely to a generous *Share Art Flint* grant provided by the Ruth Mott Foundation via the Greater Flint Arts Council, FOMA was able to add an exciting new aspect to the weekend events: a Young Artist Exhibition and Competition.

Founders Society

Letter from the President,

James D. Draper

The Founders Society pledged \$27,000 in support of the Flint Institute of Arts in our fiscal year 2013-2014. These pledges were to support the FIA as follows: \$2,000 FIA Library, \$10,000 Exhibition Sponsor of *Toulouse Lautrec & His World*, \$15,000 Graphics Gallery Sponsor. A check for \$27,000 was presented to the FIA on June 17, 2014.

From Isabel Hall to Carnegie Hall, a jazz ensemble featuring Dave Bennett and the Cliff Monear Trio was well received on October 18. It generated a net profit of \$3,492. The 2013 net revenue from *First Frost Arts & Fine Crafts Fair* in November was \$20,259. Our 3rd annual piano recital, *Romanticism Forever*, by international pianist, Idil Ulgen, on April 12, 2014, once again filled the Bray Gallery. Net income was \$3,879. On May 31 we hosted *DuMouchelles Art Galleries* for our 2nd appraisal fair which was held in Isabel Hall. This one-day event generated over \$1,700 in revenue.

In November, Founders sponsored a very successful trip to Italy that was attended by 37 patrons. We also coordinated a day trip to Grand Rapids for Art Prize. Our various travel and day trip initiatives generated a net income to Founders of \$11,306.

As of April 2014, the Art Sales & Rental Gallery has transferred \$2,500 to the Founders account. These are proceeds from its sale or rental of works of art by local artists. In addition to staffing the gallery on a daily basis, our Art Sales & Rental volunteers have been a crucial link to the public by taking reservations and ticket monies for Founders other ongoing fund raising endeavors.

In the spring of 2012, the Founders Society initiated a \$10 annual membership fee. A membership benefit package included complementary admission to the First Frost Arts and Fine Crafts Fair plus discounts and gift cards to Art Sales & Rental for Founders Society members. At our May 24 meeting, our membership was 292. The FIA collects those monies for Founders as part of the regular membership renewal process. We will receive our 2nd annual dues disbursement from the FIA after a final end-of-year membership count on June 30.

On December 2, 2013, we hosted our traditional holiday luncheon for all FIA staff members in Isabel Hall. It was our way to thank the FIA staff for the many ways in which they generously assist the Founders Society helping it fulfill its mission.

Income received from our various activities has enabled the Founders Society to fund our FIA pledge and leave us with a current balance of nearly \$83,000. A final end-of-year adjustment will be made upon receiving our dues income for this fiscal year along with finalization of expenses from the recent DuMouchelles appraisal fair. In addition to our fundraising activities this past year, members of the Founders Society have collectively donated thousands of hours of service to the ultimate benefit of the Flint Institute of Arts. The Founders Society as an organization remains strong and is committed to the support of the Flint Institute of Arts for now and into the future.

In our opinion, the financial statements referred to above present fairly, in all material respects, the financial position of Flint Institute of Arts as of June 30, 2014, and the changes in its net assets and its cash flows for the year then ended in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.

We have previously audited Flint Institute of Arts' June 30, 2013, financial statements, and we expressed an unmodified audit opinion on those audited financial statements in our report dated February 17, 2014. In our opinion, the summarized comparative information presented herein as of and for the year ended June 30, 2013 is consistent, in all material respects, with the audited financial statements from which it has been derived.

Our audit was conducted for the purpose of forming an opinion on the financial statements as a whole. The schedule of investments is presented for purposes of additional analysis and is not a required part of the financial statements. Such information is the responsibility of management and was derived from and relates directly to the underlying accounting and other records used to prepare the financial statements. The information has been subjected to the auditing procedures applied in the audit of the financial statements and certain additional procedures, including comparing and reconciling such information directly to the underlying accounting and other records used to prepare the financial statements or to the financial statements themselves, and other additional procedures in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America. In our opinion, the information is fairly stated in all material respects in relation to the financial statements as a whole.
