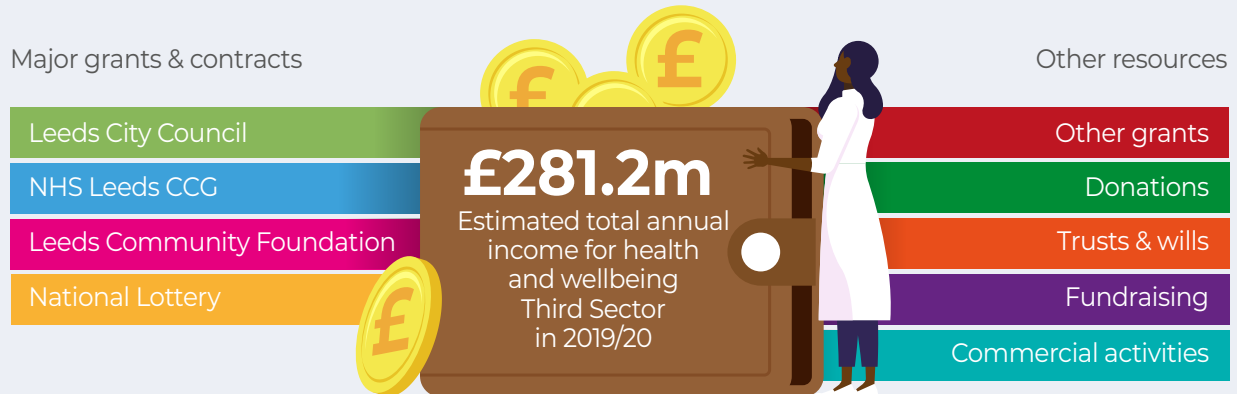

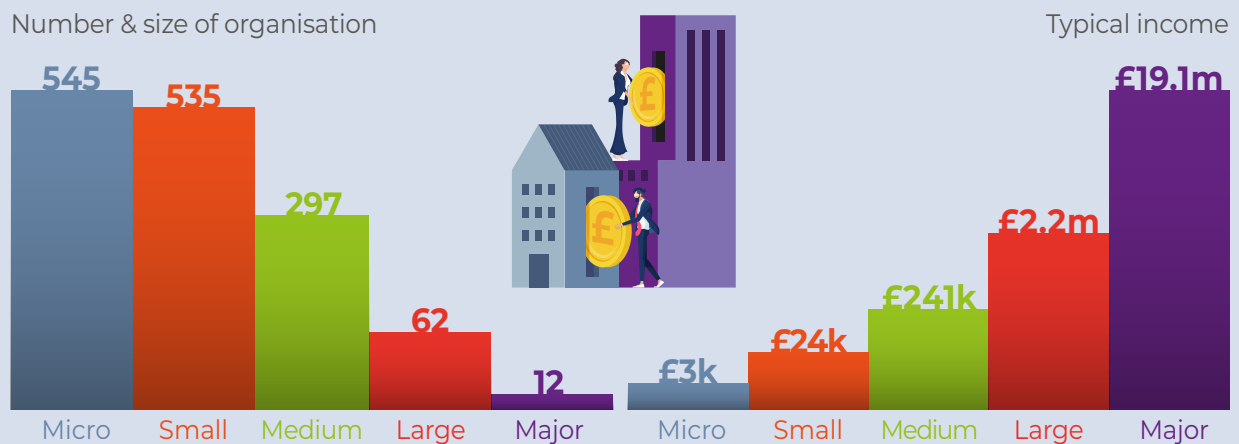
How many of these 1,533 registered charities contribute to health and care?

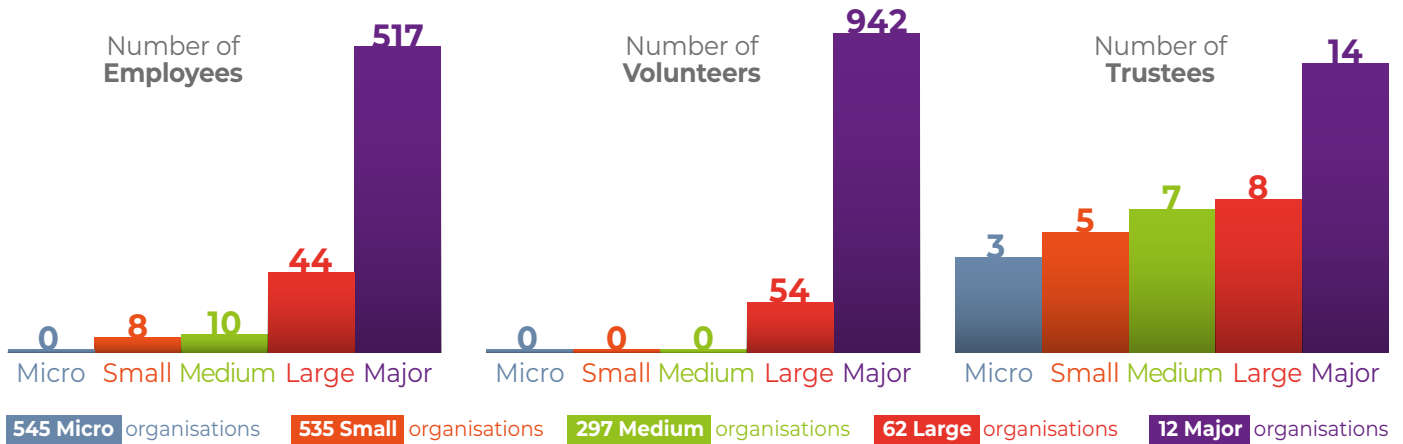
