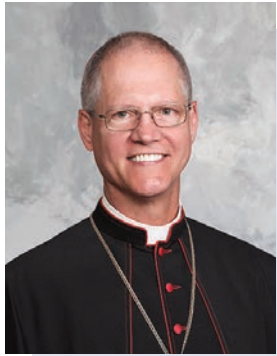

All the Stars in a Line

When their oldest son, Bentley, was entering kindergarten, Brenna and Ben Sebens toured Assumption Catholic School in Bellingham. “We were totally blown away,” Brenna recalled. “We felt so accepted and at home.”

Unfortunately, the Sebens moved and the commute and tuition costs were too much. Even so, Brenna kept thinking about Assumption, calling the school as Bentley entered first and second grade to ask about open seats.

Everything changed in 2020. The Sebens moved back to Bellingham and Brenna saw an opportunity. “I felt like God said, ‘Pick up the phone and call Assumption right now.’ I happened to have a free moment and I called. They said they had one spot open.”

“I met Ben in the driveway as he was coming home from his shift,” Brenna recalled. “I told him, ‘Assumption. We’re doing Assumption.’ And the look on his face—oh my gosh. There was so much chaos during that time of our lives, but this was a wonderful bright spot in the middle of it all.”

Both Bentley and his younger brother, Bryce, who enrolled in Assumption’s preschool, flourished in their new school. “It had been a dream for a while and God finally put all the stars in a line and we were able to do it. Assumption became this huge joy for us.”

But it wasn’t always easy. “We had so many rough financial hits during that time,” Brenna said. “And after the boys started and we saw them flourish and start to make life-long friends, we panicked that we wouldn’t be able to keep them in Assumption.”

The Sebens applied for and were awarded Fulcrum tuition assistance grants, allowing both boys to remain at Assumption.

“We could not have kept our boys in Assumption without Fulcrum,” said Brenna. “By being able to provide our children a Catholic education, we literally will see an impact on our family for generations to come. The children who have been wrapped in the fibers of Catholic education—the loving environment, the challenging education, and the support that they receive—they will have a better start, a better foundation.”

Becoming a Catholic School Leader

Shauna Richards always wanted to be a teacher.

“I have a twin sister and when we were little, we would play school together. I was always the teacher,” Shauna recalled. “My second-grade teacher had such an impact on me. This has been my life-long dream.”

For the past 15 years, Shauna has been living that dream. She taught in public schools and Catholic schools, before moving into administrative roles such as dean of students, director of pre-kindergarten, and director of admissions. Now, Shauna is taking on a new role: principal of St. Joseph Parish School in Issaquah and Snoqualmie.

“When I stepped up as dean of students, I knew becoming principal would be my trajectory,” Shauna said. “In the five years since then, I’ve had so many leadership opportunities to learn and grow, including GRACE and the Leadership Academy. I feel so much more competent in my abilities to lead a community now.”

Shauna joined the Fulcrum-funded GRACE (Growing Reflective Authentic Catholic Educators) program when she was still a second-grade teacher at St. Joseph. GRACE allowed Shauna to collaborate with teachers outside of her own school and receive resources to better help students in the classroom.

She also participated in the Fulcrum-funded Leadership Academy. “It was the first time I had the opportunity to sit with other administrators. It was interesting to learn about the dynamics of each school and how principals use their talents to help their schools. There were so many ingenious and innovative ideas that were shared,” Shauna said.

Shauna said she was looking forward to her first year as principal at St. Joseph and feels ready to step up and lead, in part thanks to her training through GRACE and the Leadership Academy. “The work that’s being done to build leadership capacity is so powerful. It’s important to know that there are so many great resources and people to lean on and ask questions. These programs helped me become the leader I am and I can still depend on them. It feels really nice to be in this position, knowing that I have people in my corner.”

Seeking What is Good, True, and Beautiful

St. Mark Catholic Classical School is always striving to serve the community.

“St. Mark Catholic Classical School was formed to be a mission for the parish and support for parents in the raising of Catholic children,” said Kathy Palmquist-Keck, principal of St. Mark. “Classical education always seeks what is good, true, and beautiful, recognizing that God is truly at the center of everything.”

The Fulcrum Foundation offered support of this mission through its School Partnership Grant Program, providing funds for much-needed technology upgrades. Through the Fulcrum grant, St. Mark purchased new projectors for classrooms and desktop computers for student workstations.

“St. Mark would not be able to afford upgrades without the support of donors,” said Kathy. “In the last ten years, the school has been granted money for laptops, desktop computers, campus security, curriculum, upgraded cabling, and a sound system... The school has been blessed by the grants received and the money has been spent to enhance and support the students who attend the school.”

Fulcrum grants given through the School Partnership Grant Program often help schools meet critical needs for students, educators, and staff—benefitting the entire school community.

“Technology is a tool for use in the building,” Kathy explained. “The students learn to keyboard starting in second grade and are introduced to Windows and its applications to enhance their learning. Students learn to create and manipulate a Word document, PowerPoint presentations, Publisher, and Excel. They learn to research and compile information for their papers. Using current technology enriches the learning of all students.”

“I am personally grateful for the continued support of the Fulcrum Foundation,” Kathy continued. “The donors make all of this possible for schools the size of St. Mark Catholic Classical School. Our school serves a population which is both economically and culturally diverse with many Eastern Orthodox and Catholic students. The grants provide much-needed support to the school: supporting parents as first educators, teaching the gospel of Jesus, forming Disciples of Christ, serving the community, and providing an excellent education that fulfills the mission of the parish and school.”
