

# GERMAN INVENTIONS 200 YEARS OF THE BICYCLE



Karl Drais invented the "Laufmaschine" (literally 'running machine,' also referred to as 'velocipede', or nicknamed the 'dandy horse') in 1817 in the German city of Mannheim.











Grußwort des Generalkonsuls der Bundesrepublik Deutschland in New York, David Gill, anlässlich "60 Jahre Steuben Parade"

Als im Jahre 1957 heimatverbundene und traditionsbewusste deutschstämmige New Yorker den ersten "deutschen" Umzug in Ridgewood/Queens ausrichteten, ahnte wohl keiner, dass sich daraus die bedeutendste deutsch-amerikanische Veranstaltung Amerikas entwickeln würde. Im September feiern wir zum 60. Mal die "German-American Steuben Parade". Sie ist nicht nur das alljährliche Aushängeschild deutschgeprägter Kultur und Tradition in dieser kosmopolitischen Stadt, sondern erinnert auch an die großen Verdienste und nachhaltigen Errungenschaften der amerikanischen Bevölkerung deutschen Ursprungs. Und sie steht auch für gelebte deutsch-amerikanischer Verbundenheit und Freundschaft, die trotz dunkler Phasen auf eine jahrhundertelange Geschichte zurückblicken kann.

Das Interesse an der Parade ist ungebrochen hoch, unabhängig davon, ob wie in diesem Jahr ein runder Geburtstag gefeiert wird, stellt sie ein wichtiges Ereignis im vollen New Yorker Festkalender dar. Das Spektakel bietet mit seinen prächtigen Festwagen und insgesamt neun Divisionen alles - vom Karnevalsdreigestirn bis zur Trachtengruppe. Unterstützung beim Feiern kommt dabei auch aus Deutschland - zahlreiche Brauchtums- und Musikantenvereine sind erneut angereist, um diesen Festumzug lebendig, vielfältig und bunt mit zu gestalten.

Amerikas Geschichte wurde schon immer von Zuwanderung geprägt. Auch die Deutschen haben eindrucksvolle Spuren hinterlassen: etwa 15 Prozent aller US-Amerikaner sind deutscher Herkunft oder Abstammung. Allein in New York City leben etwa 500.000 Deutschstämmige. Die meisten von ihnen sind hier geboren und aufgewachsen, daher bietet die Parade eine wunderbare Gelegenheit für sie alle, sich gemeinsam ihrer deutschen Wurzeln und Kultur zu besinnen.

Einen Deutschen dürften indes mehr Amerikaner als Deutsche kennen: den preußischen Offizier Freiherr Friedrich Wilhelm von Steuben, der zu einem der Helden des amerikanischen Unabhängigkeitskrieges unter George Washington wurde und der daher zu Recht Namensgeber der Parade ist.

Das deutsche Generalkonsulat in New York freut sich darauf, wie schon in der Vergangenheit, wieder mit einem eigenen Festwagen vertreten zu sein. Mein besonderer Dank gilt dem unermüdlichen Engagement der Organisatoren, den vielen ehrenamtlichen Helfern, den Förderern und Sponsoren der Steuben-Parade, die dafür sorgen, dass diese schöne Tradition auch im siebten Jahrzehnt Bestand haben wird.

Ich wünsche allen Teilnehmern und Besuchern eine fröhliche, ausgelassene Parade und natürlich viel Spaß auf dem anschließenden Oktoberfest!

On December 23, 1783, the outgoing first President of the United States of America, George Washington, wrote one last letter in which he thanked Friedrich Wilhelm von Steuben for his invaluable service:

### My Dear Baron:

Although I have taken frequent opportunities, both in public and private, of acknowledging your zeal, attention and abilities in performing the duties of your office, vet I wish to make use of this last moment of my public life to signify in the strongest terms my entire approbation of your conduct, and to express my sense of the obligations the public is under to you for your faithful and meritorious service.



Seien Sie versichert, verehrter Herr, dass ich mich freuen würde, wenn ich Ihnen je wesentlicher dienen könnte als durch diesen Ausdruck von Achtung und Wohlwollen. In der Zwischenzeit aber glaube ich, dass Sie zum Abschied dieses Zeichen meiner ehrlichen Freundschaft und Hochachtung schätzen werden.

Dies ist der letzte Brief, den ich im Dienste meines Landes schreiben werde. Die Stunde meines Rücktritts ist für 12 Uhr dieses Tages festgelegt. Danach werde ich als Privatmann an die Ufer des Potomac zurückkehren, wo ich mich freuen werde, Sie zu willkommen zu heissen und die grosse Wertschätzung zu bezeugen, mit denen ich, mein lieber Baron, Ihr gehorsamster und wohlwollender Diener bin.

I beg you will be convinced, my dear Sir, that I should rejoice if it could ever be in my power to serve you more essentially than by expressions of regard and affection. But in the meantime I am persuaded you will not be displeased with this farewell token of my sincere friendship and esteem for you.

This is the last letter I shall ever write while I continue in the service of my country. The hour of my resignation is fixed at twelve this day, after which I shall become a private citizen on the banks of the Potomac, where I shall be glad to embrace you, and testify the great esteem and consideration, with which I am, my dear Baron, your most obedient and affectionate servant.



# 60TH GERMAN-AMERICAN STEUBEN PARADE GRAND MARSHAL ADMIRAL MANFRED NIELSON



# German Armed Forces Deputy Supreme Allied Commander Transformation

Admiral Nielson was born February 25, 1955 in Dorsten, Germany. He joined the German Navy as a reserve officer candidate and graduated from Helmut Schmidt University of the Bundeswehr in Hamburg in 1978 and completed underwater weapons specialist training in 1981.

Early assignments included tours as a watch officer on coastal minesweepers Koblenz and Wetzlar, minehunters Flensburg, Cuxhaven and Koblenz and subsequently command tours of Tübingen and Paderborn. He also served as an action officer for the Armed Forces Staff at the Federal Ministry of Defence and Deputy Commander of the 6th Minesweeper Squadron in Wilhelmshaven.

Admiral Nielson has commanded units at all levels. From 1996 to 1997 he commanded the 6th Minesweeper Squadron and following his promotion to Rear Admiral (lower half), served as Commandant of the Naval Academy in Flensburg from 2003 to 2005 where he deployed to Commander Task Force 150 during Operation Enduring Freedom. Promoted to the rank of Vice Admiral in 2010, he was appointed Commander in Chief of the German Fleet in Glücksburg.

Other significant tours include service as Chief of Division I Personnel, Social Services and Central Affairs Directorate of the Federal Ministry of Defence and later as the Director of Armed Forces Staff. In April 2012 he was appointed Chief of Staff Joint Support Service of the Bundeswehr. In March 2016 he assumed duties as Deputy Supreme Allied Commander Transformation in Norfolk, Virginia.

Admiral Nielson holds a Masters Degree in Economics and Organisational Sciences and is a graduate of the Admiral Staff Officer Course at the Bundeswehr Command and Staff College in Hamburg. His personal awards include the Gold Cross of Honour, for exemplary and meritorious service, German Armed Forces Deployment Medal and the German Flood Service Medal.

Admiral Nielson is married and has an adult son and an adult daughter.

### 60TH GERMAN-AMERICAN STEUBEN PARADE GRAND MARSHAL HEINZ BUCK



Heinz Buck was born in Armstorf-Horn, Niedersachsen, Germany on July 2, 1935. After he lost his father in Russia in 1942, Heinz along with his mother and two sisters emigrated to the United States of America on February 1st, 1950 arriving on February 22nd, 1950, George Washington's birthday. He proudly became a US citizen in 1957.

Once married, the Bucks raised their two daughters in Franklin Square, Long Island. Heinz is the proud grandfather and great-grandfather of five grandchildren and 2 great-grandchildren. In 2002, widowed Heinz was remarried to the current Mrs. Buck, Renate.

Heinz learned his trade as an aircraft mechanic during a tour of duty in the United States Navy serving as a flight engineer on an admiral VIP airplane. He began his civilian career in 1959 with Pan American World Airways, repairing aircraft in all corners of the world. He simultaneously attended college to further his education specializing in Transportation Management and Labor Relations. After 33 years, having risen to the position of Director of Aircraft Maintenance, his career came to an abrupt end when Pan Am World Airways declared bankruptcy.

In March of 1992, Heinz joined a group of similarly impacted airline professionals to help form a new airline, Kiwi International Air Lines, where he served as Vice President of Maintenance and Engineering. His next career move was to accept a position with Atlas Air as the Regional Manager of Maintenance where he was based in Amsterdam, the Netherlands, for five years and responsible for managing the fleet throughout Europe, Africa, the Middle East and Asia. Heinz returned to the US based in Westchester and decided to retire after the events of September 11th, 2001.

Heinz has always been actively involved in the German-American community, predominantly with the Plattduetsche Volksfest Vereen in Franklin Square. He was elected Vice President in 1988 of the PVV and continued to serve as President of the organization from 1992 - 1993. Heinz was also a member of the Lamstedter Club where he also held the title of President. Heinz continues to be an active member of the Brooklyn Schuetzen Corp, the Bederkesa'er Club, the Otterndorfer Buelkauer Club, the Norddeutschen Brueder und Schwestern, the Sievener Club, the Steinauer Club and the Altenheim Gesellschaft. Currently, Heinz is the President of the German American Cultural Council. Heinz is also a Mason and a member of the Allemania Lodge F & AM in Whitestone, New York.

Since 1980, Heinz Buck has been an active member and supporter of the German-American Steuben Parade Committee acting as Grandstand Chairman and 1st Vice Chairman of the Executive Committee. The German American Committee of Greater New York elected Heinz as President of the GACGNY from 2005-2012.

The GACGNY and Steuben Parade Committee thank Heinz Buck for his many years of dedicated service to the German-American Community.

### HISTORY OF THE GERMAN-AMERICAN STEUBEN PARADE

"New York, the largest city in the United States, is indeed a melting pot for people from all nations", wrote Gerhard Hirseland in the 1958 journal commemorating the Steuben Parade. While they could not foresee the success the Steuben Parade would have, the founders certainly knew that it was time for an event like this. Writes Hirseland: "While people from all nations hold their marches and parades, there has for decades been one exception: One of the largest immigrant groups, which has for almost three centuries helped build America and still helps make it great, has never publicly shown their significance- the German-Americans.

"On September 20th, 1958, they put an end to this", continues Hirseland. "10,000 German-Americans marched in a long Parade up Fifth Avenue, and about 150,000 spectators cheered for their countrymen of German descent." Leading the parade as Grand Marshal was New York mayor Robert Ferdinand Wagner, the son of an immigrant from Germany's Palatinate region. By his side marched New York governor Averell Harriman and New Jersey Governor Robert Baumle Meyner, whose roots trace back to the Baden and the Alsace region in Germany.

Leaders from both the United States and Germany provided efforts to help the German-American Steuben Parade establish footing. The President of the Federal Republic of Germany, Theodor Heuss, sent the Parade Committee a German flag. President Dwight D. Eisenhower donated an American flag that shortly had been raised atop the Capitol in Washington. President Eisenhower wished to support the Steuben Parade, as he was also a German-American; in the mid 18th century his ancestors had come to Pennsylvania from the Odenwald.

The 1958 journal shows just how spectacular the first Steuben Parade was. Thousands of viewers lined up along Fifth Avenue five rows deep, waving flags and cheering for a parade that included forty-five floats. The floats varied from celebrating historical figures like Babe Ruth and the Roebling family, to reenacting scenes from Wagner's Meistersinger. On one float even swung a bell as in Schiller's Lied von der Glocke (The Song of the Bell).

Throughout the years some floats have completely changed, while some still echo motifs of the past. In 1958, the float of the New York Turners had four young men exercising on parallel bars. In recent years Johanna Quaas, a regular amateur competitor in Saxony, Germany, has performed her gymnast skills on a float.

Copies of journals from 1959 and 1960 show that many of the German-American groups who have been with the parade since the beginning are still participating. The Plattduetsche Volksfest Vereen both from Brooklyn as well as New York still join in, as do the United Bavarians. Other groups, however, stand immortalized in pictures and memory. The United Pfälzer are not around anymore, neither is the Badischer Volksfest Verein, which had a float in the first parade remembering Civil War General Franz Sigel. The 86th Street Restaurant Association is gone too, as are most of the establishments it once represented. The Heidelberg restaurant and Schaller & Weber are the last surviving witnesses of the German-American days of Yorkville.

While some German companies have closed shop over the years, among them German language newspapers and family owned breweries, many new ones have opened and flourished. Nowadays, New York has more German restaurants and bars than it has had for the past two decades. Many of these businesses actively support the parade as well as the events throughout German-American Friendship Month.

Over the past six decades, many of Germany's highest-ranking politicians have marched in the parade. Among them were Presidents Walter Scheel, Richard von Weizsäcker and Johannes Rau. Former German Chancellor Karl Carstens once led the Parade, as did Secretaries of State Hans-

Dietrich Genscher and Klaus Kinkel. Several Minister Presidents representing their states have also participated. Politicians on the American side have also shown great interest in supporting the Steuben Parade as well. Local politicians like Mayor Wagner, Rudolph Giuliani and Michael Bloomberg have recently marched. President Donald J. Trump led as Grand Marshal when he was a business mogul and television celebrity. Many other celebrities have taken part, such as actor Eric Braeden, magicians Siegfried & Roy, as well as supermodel Carol Alt.

From politicians to celebrities, many have reinforced their value for German-American friendship. The bulk of the credit goes to the thousands of volunteers who have worked tirelessly throughout the years. Many have dedicated their time to organizing various aspects of the parade from the floats and line-up, to handing out brochures, selling cornflowers, serving beer, soliciting ads, and even keeping the finances in order. Most of the duties have remained the same. For the past sixty years there have been many dedicated General Chairmen overseeing the entire organization.

There have been those who have stepped in and volunteered for a few hours, while others have dedicated more than half of their lives to the parade. To all who have been involved, our sincere thanks; you have made the German-American Steuben Parade the great and proud event it is today and will be for years to come.
