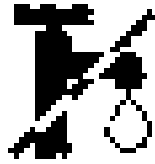


# Apricot Sparkles Daylily



## *Hemerocallis 'Apricot Sparkles'*

**Daylilies can survive many harsh conditions that other plants cannot including: polluted city environments, slopes, poor and dry soils, near pavement that is salted in winter, and under Black Walnut trees (not affected by juglone).**

- **Use:** An outstanding daylily in so many ways! Its apricot-hued flowers appear to sparkle in the afternoon sun—and it's the perfect size for containers and edging walkways and borders. It's an excellent choice for perennial flower beds, rock gardens, planting in large masses or growing as a ground cover on slopes.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun (but must be 5-6 hours of afternoon sun) . Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Once established needs only occasional water.
- **Growth:** Fast-growing to 15" high and 18-24" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Grass-like foliage.
- **Flower:** Large, 3", apricot, diamond dusted flowers with flawless form. Petals are edged with attractive ruffling; sepals are smooth. Prolific rebloomer.
