

Drupacea Japanese Plum Yew



This elegant shrub is much sought after for its graceful foliage and is excellent for a hedge that requires little maintenance.



Cephalotaxus harringtonia var. *drupacea*

- **Use:** Used for low evergreen hedges or borders, good for small gardens due to growth rate and small size; drought tolerant. Deer resistant. Drought tolerant after established; heat tolerant; not wind tolerant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun to partial shade; moist, well drained soil; dislikes wet sites. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Grows 4-5' tall and wide slow to moderately. Semi-formal, rounded; drooping branches.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5 -9 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Fern-like foliage.
- **Flower:** Insignificant flowers. Female flowers produce fleshy, edible, plum-like fruits (to 1" long). If fruits are desired, female plants with at least one male pollinator are required for fruit production to occur.
