Prunus jacquemontii 'Hirome'

- **Use:** A small weeping form which may be grown as a tree or open shrub. Do not underestimate the value of this plant if grown a shrub, it would make a unique planting in any landscape and is a great way to grow a cherry in small spaces. It is also easily formed into a small weeping specimen. Well adapted to the heat of the Deep South and not too fussy about light or soil conditions.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. Soil should be well-drained. Acidic soil is preferred, though it can tolerate a wide variety of soils. They are not drought-tolerant, so proper watering is a must.
- **Growth:** Grows 4-6' tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-8; Tree
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Dark green leaves.
- **Flower:** Beautiful light pink flowers in early spring are amount the first blooms to emerge. Flowering occurs before the foliage. The fruit 'Hiromi' produces is small and not something you would want to eat, but will attract birds and wildlife to your yard. The birds will thank you for the fruit! Blooms on OLD wood, prune after flowering! An easy-to-grow shrub that will reward you with early spring blossoms year after year.
