Cordyline manners-suttoniae (Giant Palm Lily)

Found only in Queensland in swampy areas/rainforests. Leaves are up to 65 cm long, and 12 cm wide. Flowering occurs in spring or summer, with attractive white/lavender flowers forming on panicles. Like many of the Australian Cordyline plants, red berries are another appealing ornamental feature.
