

Jagera pseudorhus (Foambark Tree)

Ornamental shade tree with fern-like foliage. It has small, yellowish-brown flowers in autumn and yellow-brown seed capsules, covered with minute hairs which irritate the skin. These split to reveal 3 dark seeds. Bark contains frothing component used by aborigines as a fish poison. Named for the saponin foam that forms on the bark after heavy rain.
