

Leptospermum liversidgei (Swamp May)

Leaves are 5-7 mm long, with a distinctive lemony aroma. The 12 mm white or pink flowers are solitary, spring to summer, followed by a woody capsule. 8mm woody fruit have 5 valves. Suitable for poorly drained areas. Used for cut flowers.
