

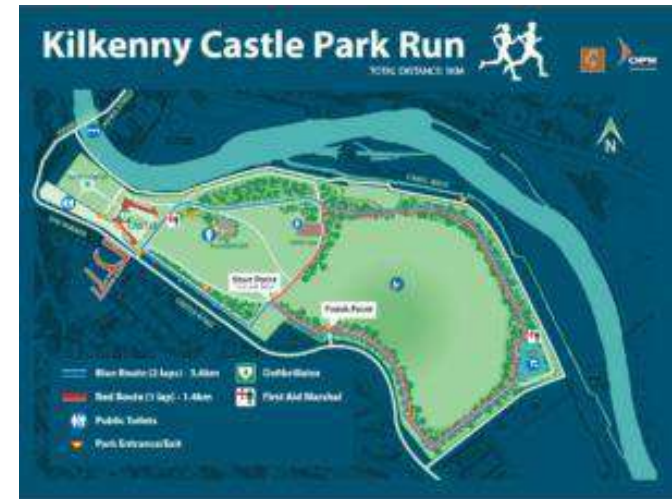
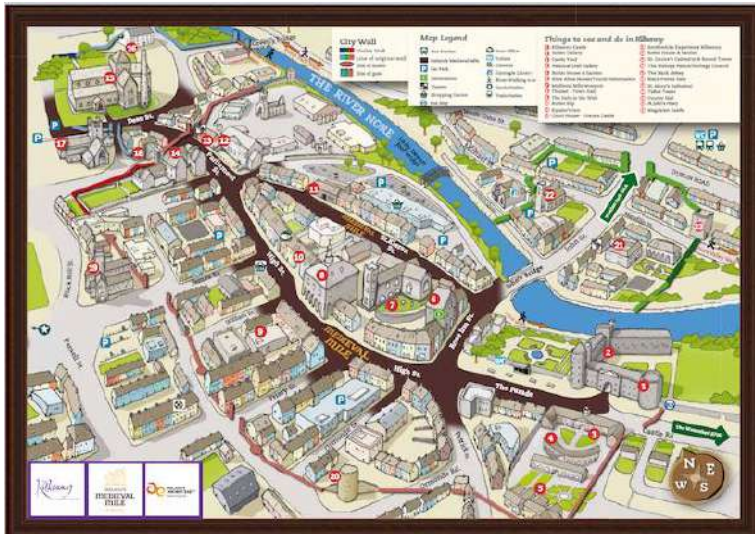
Social Story Guide

A visit to Kilkenny Castle

This is a story about visiting Kilkenny Castle.



Kilkenny Castle is a big castle the middle of Kilkenny City. The Castle has a park, with paths going through woodland areas, a pond with ducks, a Rosegarden and a playground. There is a market every Thursdays & Saturdays from 9.30am to 2.30pm just outside the Castle, it has some craft and food stalls and sometimes there are street performers & musicians. Kilkenny Castle is a very busy place with a lot of visitors.



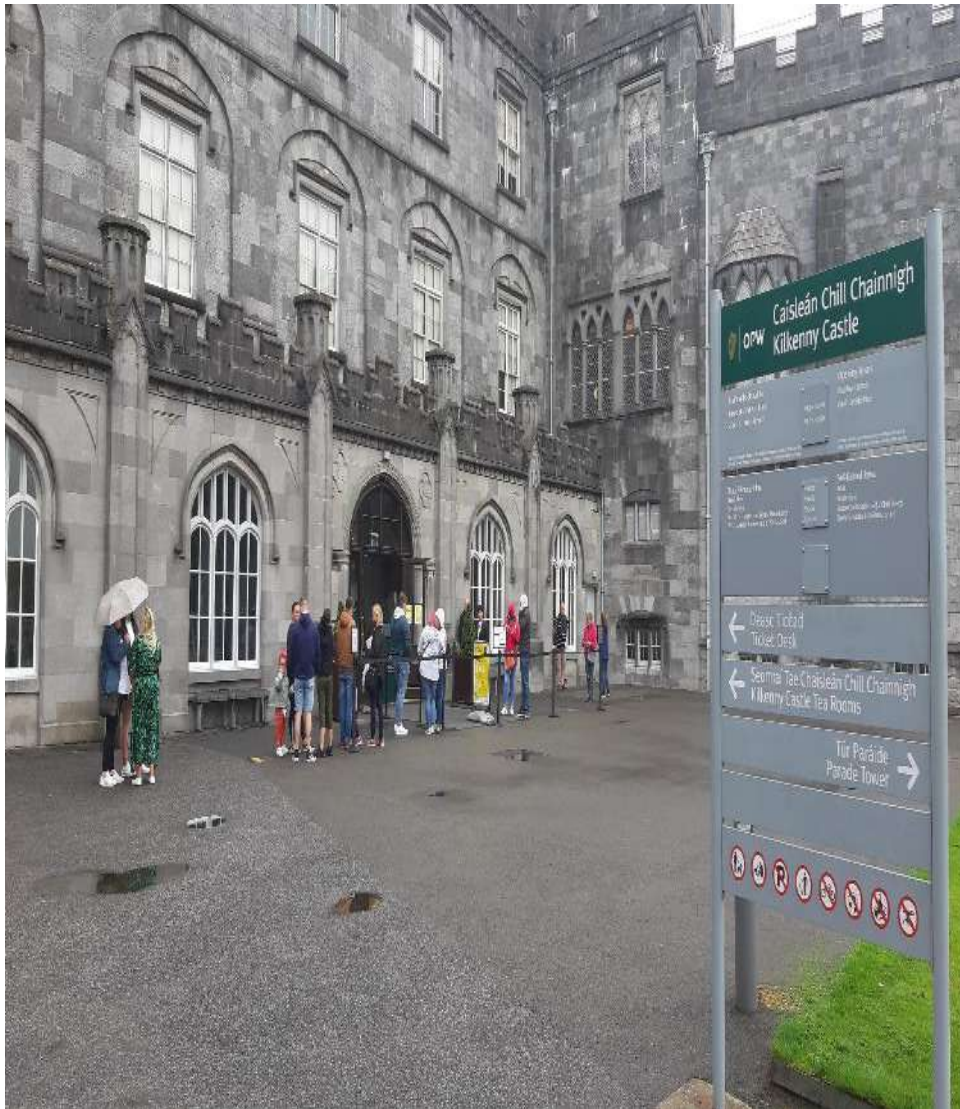


I arrive:

I enter the Castle grounds through a big gate from the street.



There will be a sign to show where I go to buy a ticket and where to queue if I have reserved my ticket on line.



There are 2 queues in the Courtyard, one for people who have reserved their ticket on line and 1 for people who have bought their ticket at the ticket desk.

Everyone has to queue outside before entering the Castle.



If I want to buy a ticket I need to queue to buy a ticket from the ticket desk under the arch.

Everyone has to queue outside to buy a ticket from the ticket desk.



If I have reserved my place in advance, I join the queue in the courtyard, with this sign:



If I just got my ticket from the ticket desk, I join the queue in the courtyard with this sign:



If waiting in line is challenging for me, I can show the Castle staff my Autism I.D card then I can go inside without waiting.

**I wait outside until a Castle staff tells me it's ok to enter.
I finish my food and drinks before I enter the Castle.**



The Castle Staff will ask everyone to wear a face mask before entering the Castle.

If wearing a face mask is uncomfortable for me, that is okay and I don't have to wear one.

I can download a letter (<https://asiam.ie/wp-content/uploads/2020/07/Face-mask-letter.pdf>) and show it to the Castle staff. The letter explains that I can't wear a face mask and this is okay.



I enter the Castle; I will have to sanitise my hands. I can use the hand sanitizer in the Castle or I can bring my own.

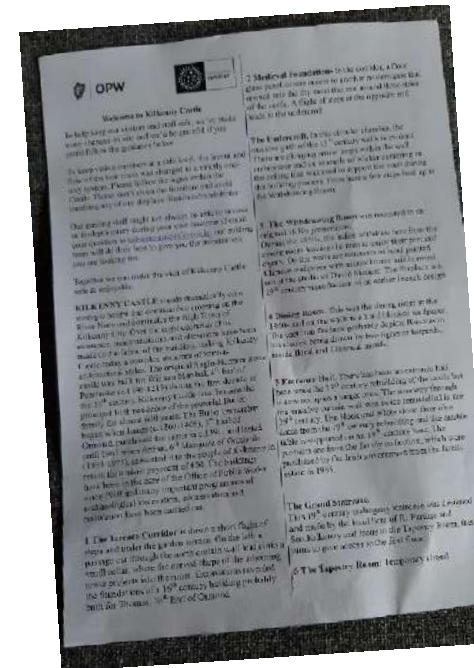
The Castle Staff will ask everyone that has bought a ticket at the ticket desk for their name and phone number in case of contact tracing.



I show my ticket to the staff member. To start my visit, I go down the corridor.



I take an information leaflet from the display and start my visit.



My leaflet has information on the rooms in the Castle.

I will have to social distance and stay away from the other people inside the Castle. If social

distancing is difficult for me, I can download a letter (<https://asiam.ie/wp-content/uploads/2020/04/Letter-regarding-social-distancing.pdf>) and show it to the Castle staff.

This letter explains that I find it difficult to social distance and that is okay.

SIGNS:

I see a lot of signs in the Castle, some of the signs give me instructions to follow, some signs give me information on the rooms I see, some signs show me where to go and other signs tell me how to protect myself and others from COVID-19

I can ask the Castle Staff if I don't understand a sign.



This type of signs give information on how to protect myself and others from COVID-19.



These mats are on the floor to show me where to go and to remind me to stay 2 meters away from other people.



This marking in the courtyard remind me to stay 2 meters away from the person in front of me when queuing in the courtyard.



This type of signs means that I cannot go in that way.



These signs tell me how many persons or family units are allowed in a room at any one time.



This sign means that I cannot sit on the furniture.



This type of signs with arrows and numbers show me the way to follow. I follow the arrows and the number in order from 1 to 10



This type of signs gives me information on the restoration work that took place in the Castle and show me photos of before and after the work. This signs are only in the Blue corridor.



This type of sign gives me information on the rooms I visit.

Visiting Kilkenny Castle




The Castle is very busy with visitors. The busiest days are Saturdays & Sundays and the busiest time is 11am to 3pm. Sometimes the Castle has quiet time visiting hours. I can find out these times by going online to the website <http://kilkennycastle.ie/> or emailing kilkennycastleinfo@opw.ie

When I visit Kilkenny Castle I will see rooms in the Castle the way they looked 200 years ago. The rooms have furniture and paintings. I will see ropes and barriers in the rooms. These are there to protect the furniture and paintings. They are very old and delicate, so no one is allowed to touch them. The Castle staff stay in the roped off areas and I stay on the other side. There are lots of sounds and noises that I might hear in the Castle. The rooms & areas I will see:

Basement

		The Undercroft	<p>To start my visit, I go down the steps and I am in the Undercroft. This part of the Castle is darker and can be damp</p>
		The Medieval Foundations	<p>I am now in the Medieval Foundations Part of the floor is a metal grid and can be very noisy. If I find the noise stressful I can ask the Castle staff to show me a different way to continue my visit. I follow the corridor</p>
		The Terrace Corridor	<p>I go up some steps from the Terrace Corridor to the Ground floor</p>

At the top of the Main Staircase I turn to my right. I am now on the First Floor. I enter the Library.

I go straight to the Drawing Room At the end of the Drawing Room I go through the door and turn left.



The Private Stairs

I go up the stone stairs to the blue corridor to the Second Floor to see more rooms in the Blue Corridor.

Second Floor

	The Blue Corridor and the exhibition rooms	<p>I reach the top of the staircase I am now on the Second Floor in the Blue Corridor</p> <p>There are lovely views of the Park from the windows on the right.</p> <p>The exhibition rooms are open for me to go in and look at the exhibitions.</p>
	Victorian Nursery	<p>After the exhibition rooms there is the Victorian Nursery. There is a plastic panel in front of the door so I can see inside. I go a little further.</p>
	The Chinese Bedroom	<p>At the end of the Blue Corridor there is plastic screen in front of a door so I can see inside the bedroom</p> <p>I turn right and go down the Moorish Staircase.</p>

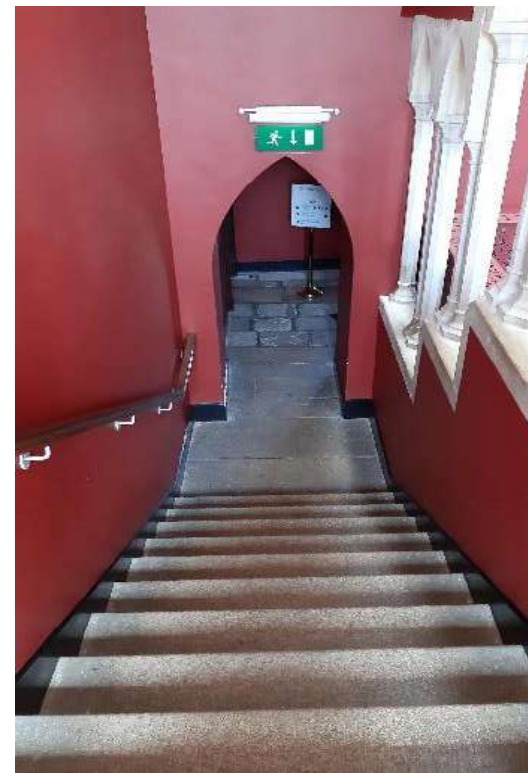


The Picture Gallery

At the bottom of the staircase I stop and look left. I will let people who are leaving the room to go before I enter. I am now in the Picture Gallery.

The Picture Gallery is the last room of the tour. There can be a lot of people but there is a lot of space for everyone. I go on the left side of the room and go on a loop following the mats. There are red benches in the middle of the room and window seats but I cannot seat on them. I leave the Picture Gallery through the same door I came in.

I follow the exit signs and go down the stairs.**



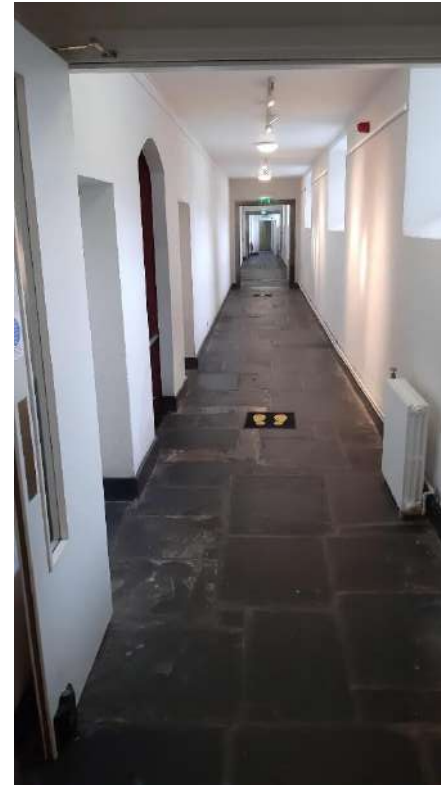
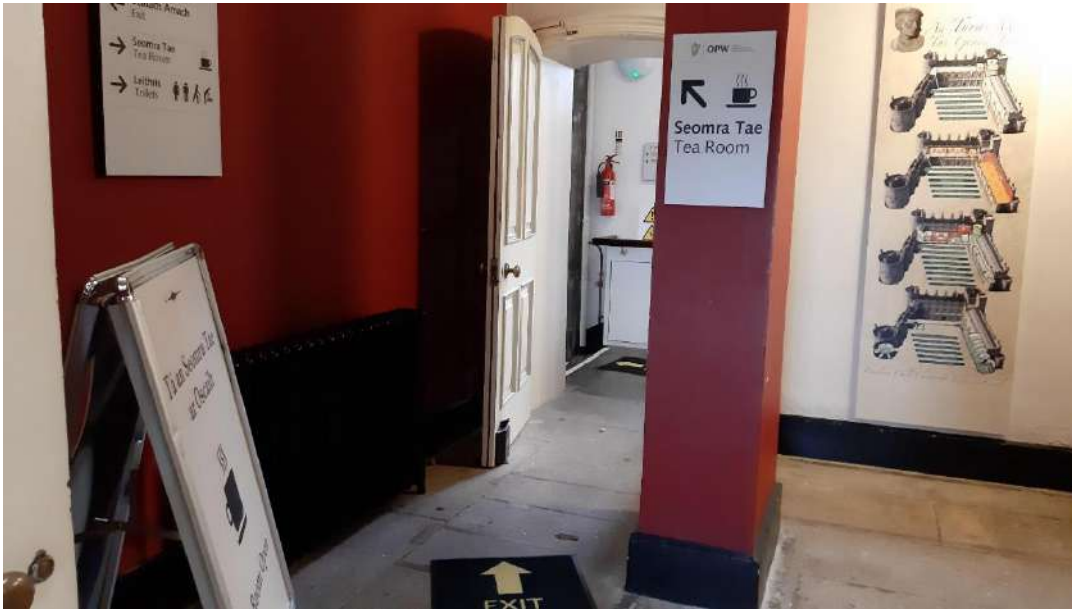
I walk along to the end of this corridor to exit.



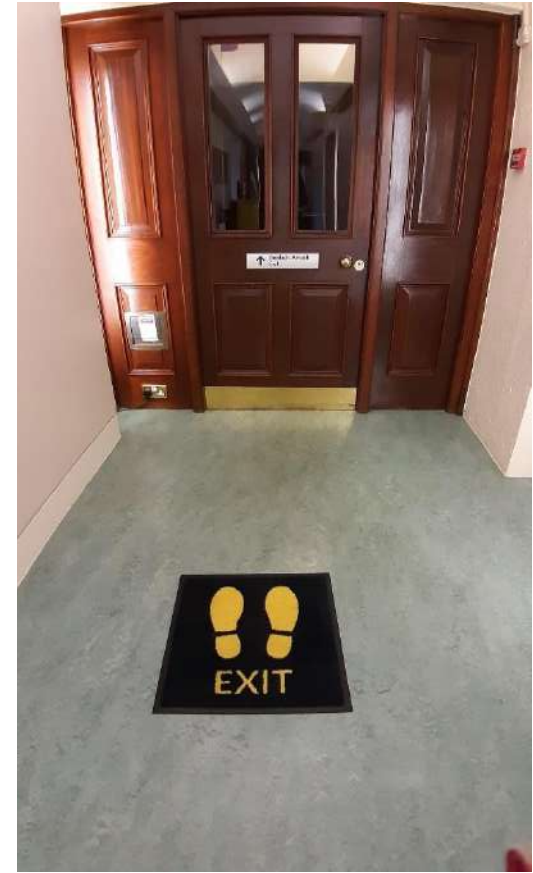
To exit, I go through the door on the far right and I go up the stairs. I push the door and I am in the Courtyard.



GOING TO THE TOILETS



After my visit I can go to the toilets. I go through the doorway and turn left. I go at the end of the corridor and go up the stairs on my left.



I walk on the left side of the Corridor. I stop at yellow counter and I wait my turn to enter. It might be busy and I might need to queue. When I leave the toilets I go to my right and go down the stairs to the exit.

Staff

I will meet Castle Staff at the Ticket Desk and in the rooms.

The Castle Staff can answer questions I have about the Castle's history and they are here help me. If I am overwhelmed and need to go to the quiet space, I can ask one of the Castle Staff to bring me there.

The Castle staff wear face masks or face shields.

They don't have a uniform but wear dark colours, usually black & navy.

The Castle staff wear badges and lanyards around their neck.

The Castle staff have completed the AsIAm Autism Awareness Course.



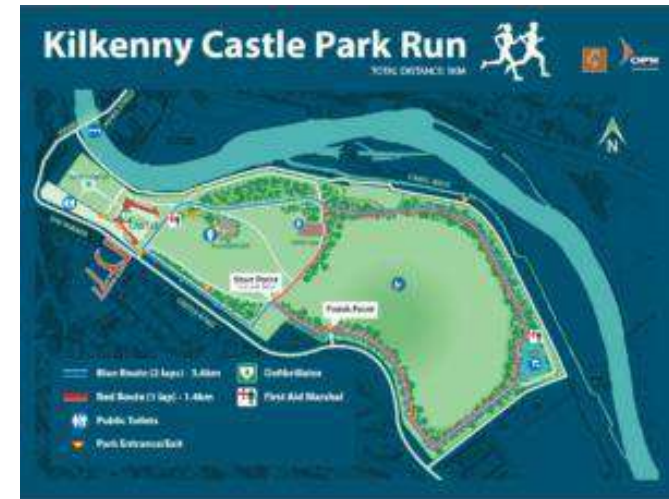
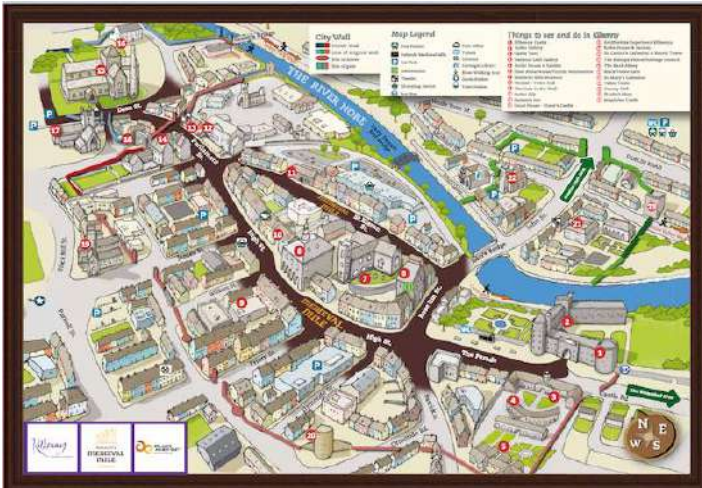

Téim síos staighre agus leanaim na comharthaí don bhealach amach.



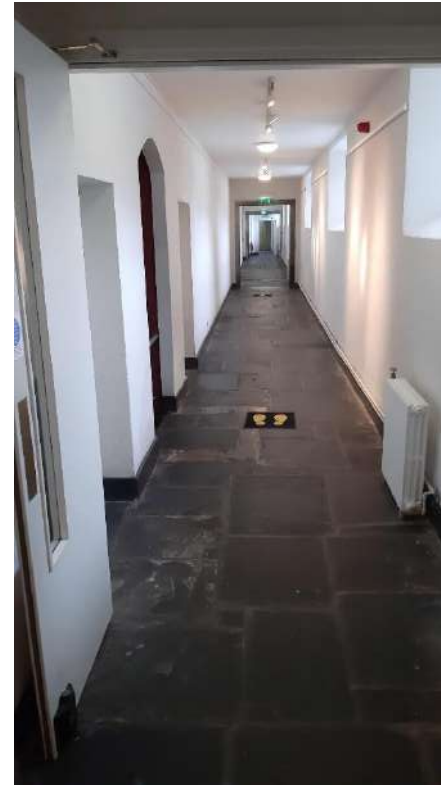
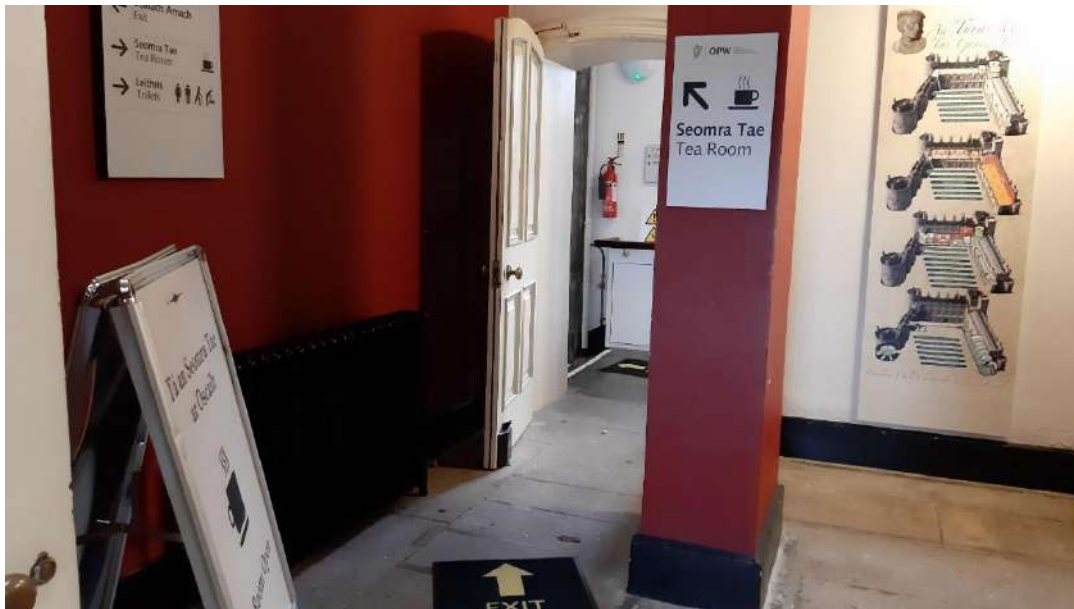

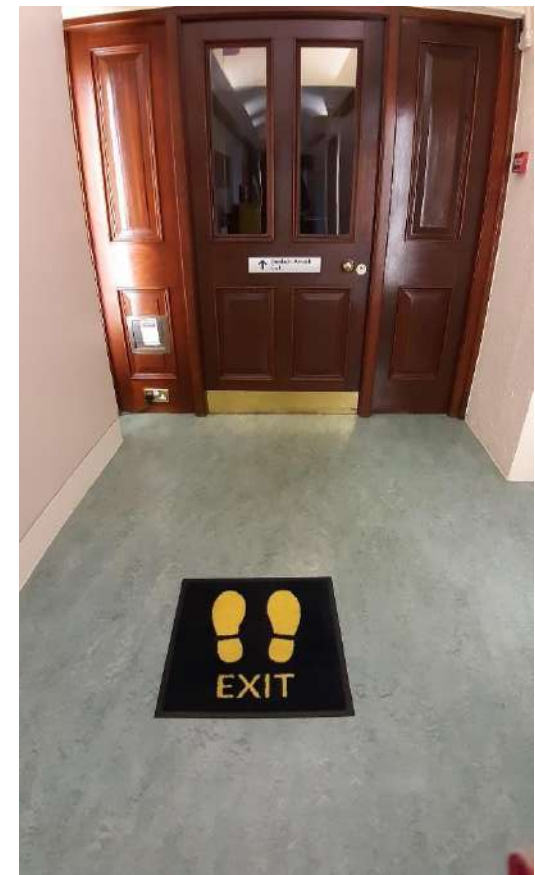
