ID: Conspicuous zones w/ various contrasting colors; fan-/kidney-/funnel-shaped. Pores creamy ochre, small.

Habitat: Solitary, overlapping clusters or rows. On dead hardwood.

Fruiting Body: 0.6 – 3.9" [1.5 – 9 cm]

Various contrasting colors (whitish/grayish/pale brown/darkbrown) in conspicuous concentric zones/shallow furrows. Upper surface uneven/warty. Fan-/kidney-shaped. Margin thick and blunt. Flesh white; thin layer.

Pores: White/cream dull yellow/brownish in age). Circular, angular in age (2-3/mm).

Spores: White.

Frequency: Uncommon.

Locations: OTHER.
