**ID:** White, vaguely circular disc; small pores; off-center stalk.

**Habitat:** Solitary, groups. Attached to dead wood in deciduous forests, sometimes on buried wood; rarely on conifers.

**Fruiting Body:** 0.5 – 2.8" [1.2 – 7 cm]

White (cream/ochraceous in age); zonate w/ grayish/umber zones. Circular or kidney-/spoon-/fan-shaped. Velvety/tomentose (glabrous in age). Fibrous tough (hard and brittle in age). Margin thin, acute.

**Pores:** White (cream/pale straw-colored in age); angular (6 – 8/mm).

**Stalk:** Up to 2.8 x 1/16 – 1/4" [7 cm x 2 – 6 mm]

White to ochraceous. Sometimes absent. Wrinkled/irregular in age.

**Spores:** White. Nearly round, smooth, hyaline.

**Frequency:** Very common.

**Locations:** ANNRK, CEDLP, DANPV, FRANF, GONRA, HAMVL, MANWD, MURHL, MCHPV, OTHER, PIGTL, RKBRP, SLMLP, SYRIV, TRIRS, WINTR.

**Notes:** Mycobank 317697. Montgomery County specimen identified by examination of spores by R. Solem.
