ID: Body medium-/dark-brown, cushion-shaped (young), cup-shaped (mature); rubbery.

Habitat: Solitary, small groups. On soggy, water-soaked hardwood logs.

Fruiting Body: 0.8 – 1.6" (max 3.2") [2 – 4 (8) cm]
 Medium-/dark-brown (fertile); white/light brown (infertile). Cushion-shaped (young); cup-shaped (mature). Flesh gelatinous (whitish; becoming yellow).

Spores: *Hyaline*. Broadly ellipsoid, smooth, hyaline w/ 1-2 oil drops

Stalk: None.

Frequency: Uncommon.

Locations: MCHPV, PIGTL, SLMLP, ZIRNP.

Notes: Mycobank 302173. Pigtail record identified by examination of spores by R. Solem; Morning Choice Trail record identified by R. Orr.
