This list relies heavily on the works of Coe (1901, 1904, 1905, 1944). The higher taxonomy follows Chernyshev (2003) for the 'Enopla' (here Hoplonemertea) taxa. I have avoided the use of Anopla and Enopla in this list. This is because there is some conflict with higher level taxonomies and these terms are in dispute. I included every species for which there is a confirmed British Columbia record. This list is certainly incomplete, and requires additions.
