Bird Species: The most critical bird species are as follows (IUCN Categories):

Critically Endangered

El Oro Parkeet *Pyrrhura orcesi* (population between 300-500, reduced habitat, threats from poaching for pet trade, occurs in 3-4 known locations)

El Oro Tapaculo *Scytalopus robbinsi* (this is essentially a hyper endemic – now extirpated from other areas where it occurred; population unknown. For unknown reasons, it is now very rare at Buenaventura when it once was formerly common.)
