

PLANTS OF ARASBARAN PROTECTED AREA, NW. IRAN (PART II)

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The second part of a paper dealing with the plants of Arasbaran Protected Area is presented. It covers the rest of the Dicotyledones from *Leguminosae* up to the end in alphabetical order and all of the Monocotyledones. The first part was including introduction, notes on the vegetation, phytogeographical evidences and list of species including *Pteridophyta*, *Gymnospermae* and the Dicotyledones to *Labiatae* in alphabetical order. In this part number of species is added to 785. *Onobrychis transcaucasica* and *Alchemilla pseseudo - cartalinica* are added to the list of new plant records, therefore number of new plant records to Iran reaches to 55 in all. References for the two parts are mentioned at the end of the paper.

گیاهان منطقه حفاظت شده ارسباران ، شمال غربی ایران (قسمت دوم)

بخش دوم مقاله‌ای که در خصوص گیاهان منطقه حفاظت شده ارسباران است،
ارائه می‌گردد . این بخش شامل بقیه دولپهای‌ها از خانواده *Leguminosae*
تا پایان و تمام تک لپهای‌ها است . در این قسمت تعداد گونه‌های موجود در منطقه
به ۷۸۵ افزایش می‌یابد . گونه‌های *Onobrychis transcaucasica*،
و *Alchemilla pseudo - cartalinica* نیز به جمع گزارشات جدید اضافه و با این
ترتیب جمما " ۵۵ گونه برآسas جمع آوری‌های تحت مطالعه مذکور برای اولین بار
از ایران گزارش می‌شود . مراجع متعلق به دو بخش از مقاله مذکور نیز در پایان
این مقاله ذکر می‌شود .

INTRODUCTION

This is the second part of a paper dealing with floristic studies in Arasbaran Protected Area. The first part was published in previous number of Iranian Journal of Botany (cf. Assadi 1987).

DICOTYLEDONES (cont.)

Leguminosae

Seen in *Quercus* forests. Distribution in Caucasia, E. Turkey and NW. Iran.

Astragalus aureus Willd. — Doghroon mountain, 2500 — 2800 m, A. & S. 23975, R. & A. 20995, A. & S. 23949, A. & S. 23883.

Astragalus bungeanus Boiss. — Between Tolua — Ali and Veinagh, 900 m, A. & V. 24601, W. of Makidi, ca. 2000 m, R. & A. 20233; between Vaighan and Veinagh, ca. 1000 m, A. & M. 20426; between Veinagh and Ghaghloou, 1000 m, A. &

M. 20509.

A variable species which rarely have been recorded from NW. Iran. Above specimens were compared with the type and they are matched. It has been written in the literature that the colour of flower is violet, but living material of above mentioned numbers had rosy - red flower which changed to violet in pressing. Distributed in Caucasia and NW. Iran. *Astragalus declinatus* Willd. — Doghroon mountain, 2800 m, dry meadow, R. & A. 21902, A. & S. 23920.

Distributed in Caucasia, E. Turkey and NW. & N. Iran.

Astragalus aff. *dolichophyllus* Pall. Between Kharil and Makidi, 1900 m, A. & V. 24967; western part of Makidi, 2300 m, A. & M. 20244.

The specimens might well be a new species. It differs from *A. dolichophyllus* in leaf, calyx and standard lamina characters. It however differs from the other close species *A. humilis* mainly in the indumentum.

Astragalus fabaceus M.B. — Between Tolua - Ali and Veinagh, 1000 — 1200 m, A. & V. 24636; between Vaighan and Veinagh, ca. 1000 m, A. & M. 20437.

Similar to *A. angustiflorus*, but leaves ovate - orbicular (not ovate - elliptic). Distributed in Caucasia, E. Turkey and NW. Iran.

Astragalus finitimus Bge. — Savabi s.n.
Astragalus glycyphyllos L. subsp. *glycyphylloides* (DC.) Matthews. — Between Saigram - Dagh and Kaleibar, 2000 m, in forest, A. & S. 24358; Doghroon and Kalan mountains, 2300 — 2500 m, A. & S. 24090, R. & A. 21974; Savabi & Raofi s.n.

Calyx with black or white hairs; leaflets up to 6 cm; legumes erect or pendulous. Considering differential characters used by Chamberlain and Matthews (1970 p. 97) in Flora of Turkey to distinguish *A. fraxinifolius* DC. from *A. glycyphyllos*, these characters are comprising both species and therefore not significant to keep them as distinct species. Euro - Siberian element, extends from E. Europe to Caucasia and N. Iran.

Astragalus hamosus L. — Ghaghalous, 650 m, A. & V. 24560.

Astragalus aff. *laguriformis* Freyn. — Doghroon mountain, 2500 — 2800 m, A. & S. 23998, A. & S. 23999 (white-flowered form); between Doghroon and Saigram - Dagh mountains, 2300 -- 2500 m, A. & S. 24177; W. of Makidi, A. & M. 20216, Doghroom mountain, 2400 — 2700 m, A. & S. 24323; A. & S. 23882, Savabi 150; Doghroon mountain, 2300 m, R. & A. 20988.

Flower colour is usually purple but white form also occur in the area.

The specimens differ from *A. laguriformis* in having styles hairy only at the extreme base (not basal 2/3 hairy), from *A. porphyrodon* Townsend by longer calyx ca. 16 mm (not 11 — 13 mm) and different bract shape, and also from *A. lagurus* Willd. by having globose inflorescence (not cylindric), shorter peduncles and etc.

Above specimens somewhat diverge from the description of *A. lagurus* in having bracts barely shorter than the calyx (not equal or longer), this falls the specimens to the description of *A. persicus* (DC.) Fisch. & Mey. but as the flower colour of *A. persicus* has been said to be purple (not yellow) and as Townsend (1974 p. 372) keeps it as a synonym of *A. lagurus*, I conservatively use the older name *A. lagurus*.

Astragalus macrourus Fisch. & C.A. Mey. Mountains S. of Kharil, 2000 — 2500 m, A. & M. 20257; between Kharil and Makidi, on meadows, A. & V. 24894a. *Astragalus maximus* Willd var. *maximus* — Doghroon mountain, 2500 — 2800 m,

New to Iran. A tall plant up to 1 m high, growing on meadows, the size of inflorescence varies from 4—12 cm which is somewhat longer than what has previously been mentioned (up to 9 cm). It is distributed in Caucasia, E. Turkey and NW. Iran.

Astragalus microcephalus Willd. — Between Vaighan and Kharil, ca. 1500 m, A. & V. 24798; between Tolua - Ali and Veinagh, 800 m, A. & V. 24590. *Astragalus robustus* Bge. — Between Veinagh and Vaighan, 1000—1400 m, A. & V. 24711, A. & M. 20428.

Distributed in NW. Iran and Caucasia. *Astragalus rostratus* C.A. Mey. — Between Kharil and Makidi ca. 2000 m, on meadows, A. & V. 24986, A. & V. 24894.; W. of Makidi 20223; Doghroon mountain, 2500—2800 m A. & S. 24000.

It has only been recorded from Iran in general distribution of Flora of the USSR. Some specimens were compared with the photograph of the type and they are well matched. Growing above the forest on alpine meadows. Flower colour varies from greenish - yellow to greenish - violet. Distributed in Caucasia (Talysh) and NW. Iran.

A frequent component of scrub forests.

Lathyrus laxiflorus (Desf.) O. Kuntze subsp. *laxiflorus* — Between Veinagh and Vaighan, 1000—1400 m, in *Quercus*

Distributed from S. Europe eastwards to Caucasia and N. & NW. Iran.

Lathyrus pratensis L. — Doghroon mountain, 2200 — 2400 m, R. & A. 21926; Savabi & Raofi s.n.

A widespread Euro - Siberian element distributed from Europe eastwards to N. Iran and extends to Himalayas. *Lathyrus roseus* Stev. — Mountains E. of Vaighan, 1300 — 1600 m, A. & M. 20297. *Lathyrus rotundifolius* Willd. subsp. *miniatus* (M.B. ex Stev.) In Flora Iranica (cf. Rechinger 1984 p. 412) only mentioned from Talish and therefore new to Iran. Distributed in Caucasia, NE. Turkey and NW. Iran. This species is apparently closely related to *O. altissima* Grossh., but it is said that differs from it in having fruits with clearly dentate crest (not entire or subentire).




Fig. 3. *Papaver bipinnatum* ($\times 0.6$).




Fig. 4. *Papaver curviscapum* ($\times 0.6$).




Fig. 5. *Fragaria vesca* (nat. size).




Fig. 7. *Seseli peucedanoides* ($\times 0.57$).




Fig. 9. *Bromus adjaricus*. Habit ($\times 0.3$). — A. Spikelet ($\times 1.2$). — B. Lower glume ($\times 5.4$). — C. Upper glume ($\times 5.4$). — D. Lemma ($\times 5.4$). — E. Palea ($\times 5.4$).




Fig. 13. *Milium effusum* ($\times 0.65$).




Fig. 14. *Trisetum flavescens* subsp. *flavescens*. Habit ($\times 0.5$). — A. Spikelet ($\times 3$). — B. Upper glume ($\times 3$). — C. Lower glume ($\times 3$). — D. Lemma ($\times 3$). — E. Palea ($\times 3$).




Fig. 15. *Iris acutiloba* subsp. *lineolata* ($\times 0.74$).
