



Israel: Info Points and Prayer Targets

Introduction

As many of you know in the past few weeks millions of believers across the World had compromised to join from May 7-28 in the Isaiah 62 Fast, a call to fast and pray daily for Israel for 21 days. From the moment I was in the call where they were discussing how this came to be, the sociology part of my brain started to wonder about the current situations of Israel. And I started thinking: 21 days praying for Israel: What should we pray for? Where should we focus our prayers? What's the biggest needs currently in Israel? and so on many more questions. I must advise I am NOWHERE near being a pastor or a theologian or an expert on this subject. I am just an intercessor with an inquisitive mind; and I set my mind on the quest of trying to understand some informational points to help aim my prayers; and I am sharing with you what I found, in hopes it will help you aim your prayers too.

And I say aim because one of my favorite definitions of intercession is what we have translated from the Hebrew word *paga*. And *paga* means reach a mark, to attack, to aim, meaning that our intercessions are targets. Thinking of this whenever I join in prayer with a larger group of believers, I have this vision in my mind that as our prayers/intercession go up to the throne they are lighting up beams that signal to heaven that there is a target in Earth that is demanding attention from the throne. Like a batman sign or a laser target beam that goes all the way to heaven. So, to think that not dozens, or hundreds or thousands but **millions of believers will be signaling to heaven going Father we join your Words over Israel, send your angels with answers for these prayers is going to be something powerful**. Our targets should be well-focused because we are for sure getting answers from sending millions of beams up.

Is the hope of my heart that this basic informational points and prayer targets, help your prayer time and that it helps you to converse with other believers about the importance of praying for Israel and in general the importance of joining together in intercession as the body of Christ.



I. Why believers need to pray for Israel?

A. As believers we are called to pray and intercede for all people and kings.

1 Timothy 2:1-2 - 1 I urge, then, first, that petitions, prayers, intercession, and thanksgiving be made for all people—**2** for kings and all those in authority that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness.

B. We are called to pray for Jerusalem and there is even a promise to prosper as we pray for them.

Psalms 122:6 - ⁶Pray for the peace of Jerusalem: "May those who love you be secure.

C. Paul exemplifies that we should desire and pray for the salvation of the Israelites.

Romans 10:1 - Brothers and sisters, my heart's desire and prayer to God for the Israelites is that they may be saved.

D. God's promises over Israel are not over, He will keep and fulfill His promises over them.

Jeremiah 31:35-37 - ³⁵This is what the LORD says, he who appoints the sun to shine by day, who decrees the moon and stars to shine by night, who stirs up the sea so that its waves roar the LORD Almighty is his name:³⁶ "Only if these decrees vanish from my sight," declares the LORD, "will Israel ever cease being a nation before me." ³⁷This is what the LORD says: "Only if the heavens above can be measured and the foundations of the earth below be searched out will I reject all the descendants of Israel because of all they have done," declares the LORD.

Isaiah 49:15 - ¹⁵"Can a mother forget the baby at her breast and have no compassion on the child she has borne? Though she may forget, I will not forget you!

Romans 11:29 - ²⁹for God's gifts and his call are irrevocable.

E. When God called Abraham and promised will become a great nation (Israel) and God promised to bless those who bless Israel.

Genesis 12:3 - And I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing. ³ I will bless those who bless you, and him who dishonors you I will curse, and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed.



F. God’s plan for Israel is to give her hope and future.

Jeremiah 29:11 - ¹¹ For I know the plans I have for you,” declares the LORD, “plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.

G. God promised to heal the land if we humble ourselves and seek him and pray.

2 Chronicles 7:14 – ¹⁴ if my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land.

H. Jewish people and Jerusalem leaders recognizing Jesus as the Messiah must be fulfilled before the return on Jesus.

Matthew 23:39 - For I tell you, you will not see me again until you say, ‘Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord.

II. What about Isaiah 62?

The leaders that spearheaded this Isaiah 62 Fast, felt led to use the words of Isaiah 62 as the focus during this prayer time. “According to God’s promise in Isaiah 62:6 to sovereignly “set,” “appoint,” or “mark” intercessors who will remind the Lord of His promises for Jerusalem until Jesus returns. Isaiah 62:6 is an end-time promise that is now escalating across the earth.”ⁱ

⁶On your walls, O Jerusalem, I have appointed [set, KJV] watchmen; all day and all night they will never keep silent. You [intercessors] who remind the Lord, take no rest for yourselves; ⁷And give Him no rest until He makes Jerusalem a praise in the earth [at Jesus’ return]. (Isa. 62:6-7, NAS)

Those participating in this fast are taking a stand of recognizing they feel call to intercede on behalf of Israel.

III. Logistics: How do I pray for an hour every day for 21 days?

Prayer:

While prayer is something we are called to do on a regular basis, the reality is that a lot of believers don’t practice praying daily. The following recommendations are suggestions to help you set aside the prayer time for this moment but also something that could be applied to everyday to cultivate a stronger prayer life.



A. Be Intentional

We live in a hustling and buzzing time that requires a lot of our time and attention, just like we do when we are starting to cultivate a relationship, we need to intentionally set aside time for prayer.

B. Set Alarms

Sounds basic, but sometimes we fail in the little things. Make sure to review your schedule and evaluate your daily engagements and needs and set alarms to remind yourself of the times you have compromise to pray.

C. How do I get to at least an hour a day?

Depending on your schedule and personal needs, here are some suggestions on how you can achieve praying for an hour daily. Set 1 full hour of your time aside.

1. Do two prayers times of 30 minutes, for example when you wake up in the morning and before you go to sleep at night.
2. Do four times of 15 minutes. For someone with a busier schedule this option of dividing the time into smaller segments might be beneficial. For example, do 15 minutes when you wake up or while you are driving your car. 15 minutes during your lunch break, 15 minutes after you are done with work/school or on the drive home and 15 minutes before you go to sleep.
3. Do six times of 10 minutes. For someone with a busier schedule this option of dividing the time into smaller segments might be beneficial. For example, do 10 minutes when you wake up, 10 while preparing breakfast or while you are driving your car. 10 during a quick morning break, 10 minutes during your lunch break, 10 minutes in an afternoon break, 10 minutes after you are done with work/school or on the drive home and 10 minutes before you go to sleep.



4. Although the call had been for people to join for an hour per day, if your work or family needs don't allow you to do this, that doesn't mean you can't participate. You can choose to set aside a specific day or days to do it. The important thing is to join and be a part of this, especially if you have got the opportunity connect with other believers in you are.

D. Speak with your pastor or your church leaders or other Christian friends and try to coordinate a time when you all can join together in prayer for Israel.

E. If you don't have any other believers near you that are joining the fast, you can up join online calls and follow the transmission of the houses of prayer and ministries that are participating. IV. Logistics: How do I fast for 21 days?

A. Be Intentional

Is important that if you are going to join in fasting during these 21 days you pray and plan what type of fasting you will be doing and how it will impact your daily life.

B. Why Fasting?

Fasting is important because it makes us more sensitive to the Holy Spirit. When we fast, we are denying ourselves the pleasure of eating or doing something we find pleasurable to declare we submit and surrender to God. It is an act of humility and worship, in recognition that we are asking God to cleanse our bodies and take away anything that hinders our connection with Him. Some Christian leaders through Church history have call the union of fasting and praying an Atomical Spiritual Bomb, for the power it has, to align ourselves with God's purposes.

-  We fast to minister to the Lord – **Acts 13:2-3**
-  We fast to increase our faith – **Matthew 17:19-21, Isaiah 58:14**
-  We fast to fully give ourselves to prayer – **1 Corinthians 7:5**
-  We fast to be in the Spirit – **Colossians 3:5**



C. Most important before fasting.

PRAY and consider your physical and medical needs. It is important that before choosing what type of fast you will do you take time to ask the Holy Spirit to guide you on how to fast. Also take into consideration that if you have medical conditions, you are pregnant or have a job that is physically strenuous you should consult your doctor before choosing to do a fast.

D. Types of Fasting:

1. Intermittent Fasting – abstaining from eating any type of food for a given amount of time.
 - Hours – abstaining from consuming food or drinks for a given number of hours 8-12-16-24 hours.
 - Days – abstaining from consuming food or drinks on a specific day or days for a given number of days.
 - Liquid Fast – abstaining from eating solid foods and only consuming liquids for a given period.
2. Bread and water fast – consuming only natural bread and water for a given period of time.
3. Daniel Fasting – this fast is model after the fast Daniel did as explain on **Daniel 10**. Consists on eating the portions of fruits, vegetables, nuts, legumes and whole grains, and only drinking water or natural juices. While avoid eating carbs, meats, sugars, baked goods, sweets, soda, coffee, alcohol, dairy or other pleasurable foods or drinks.
4. Exclusion Fasting – in this type of fasting you exclude certain types of food and/or drinks for a given period. For example, not having any sweets or fried foods for the duration of the fast. The idea is not for it to be a diet but for it to be sacrificial of something you are willing to give up to focus and show your compromise to God for what you are praying for during the time of fasting



5. Entertainment and/or Social Media Fasting – This type of fast is focus on giving up on things that you enjoy and consume your time and instead focus on using that type to be spent in prayer and meditating on the Bible.

6. Other Biblical references to Fasting:

Exodus 34:18, Judges 20:26, 1 Kings 21:27, 1 Chronicles 10:12, 2 Chronicles 20:3, Esdras 8:21-23, Esdras 10:6, Nehemiah 9:1, Esther 4:16, Daniel 6:18, Daniel 10, Jonah 3:5-8, Matthew 4, Luke 4, Matthew 9:14, Luke 2:336-38, Acts 9:9-19, Acts 10:10, Acts 13:1-3, Acts 14:23, 2 Corinthians 6:5-7...

V. Consider taking communion during the fast

A. By taking communion we proclaim the triumph of the salvation of the Jews during the Passover and their deliverance from Egypt. And in doing so we prophesy that the powers that currently try to destroy God's people won't prosper as we are save and cover by the blood of the Lamb.

B. By taking communion we remember the sacrifice of Jesus and the power of His blood.

C. The Holy Spirit had been stirring believers across the nations to have better understanding on the importance of partaking on Communion.

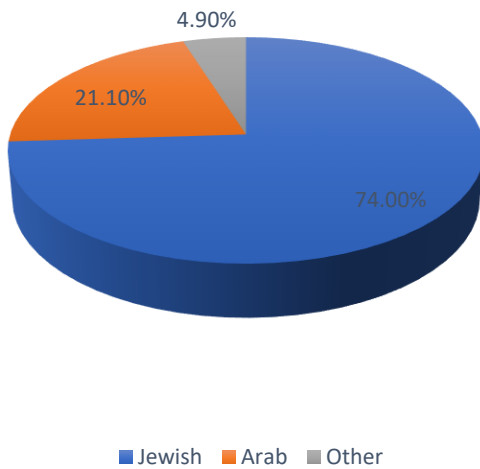
D. Pray that you receive a renewed revelation of the meaning of Communion and look up more information on The Great Communion Revival.

E. **1 Corinthians 11:26** - ²⁶For whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes.

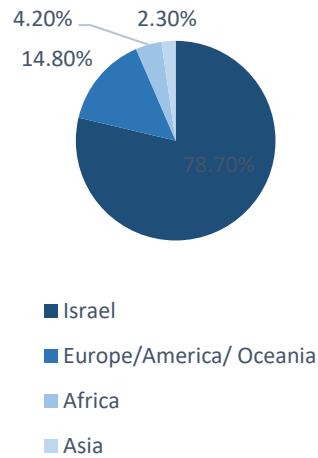

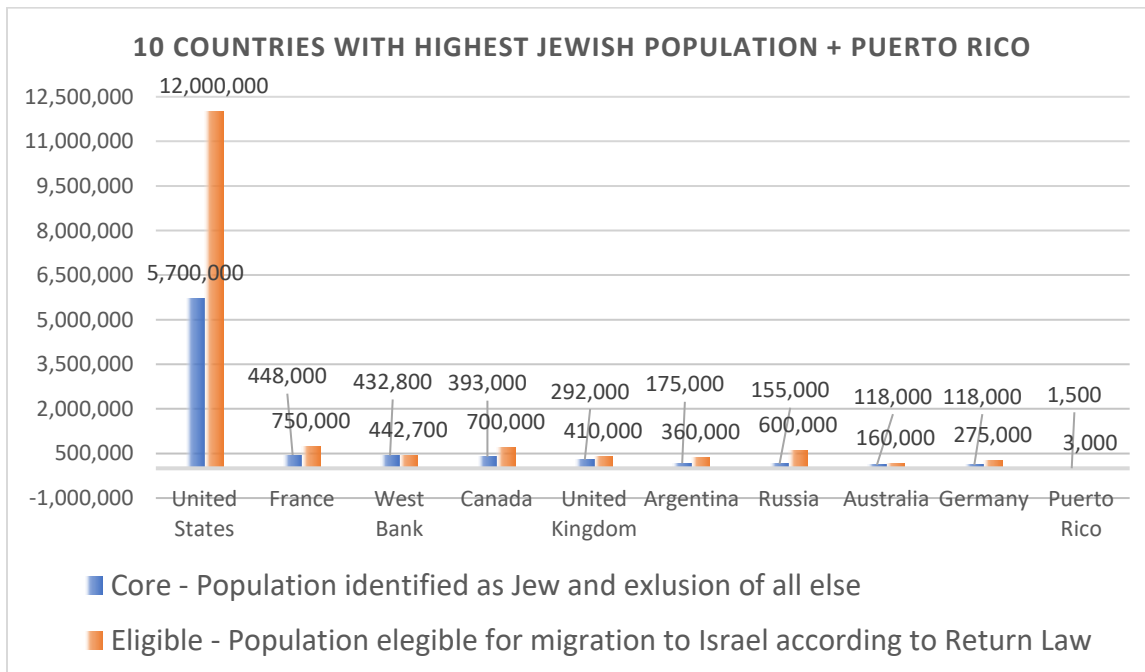
Ethnic Background

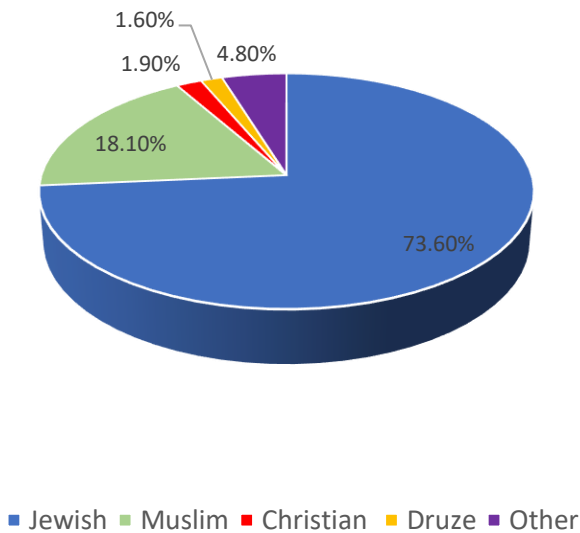

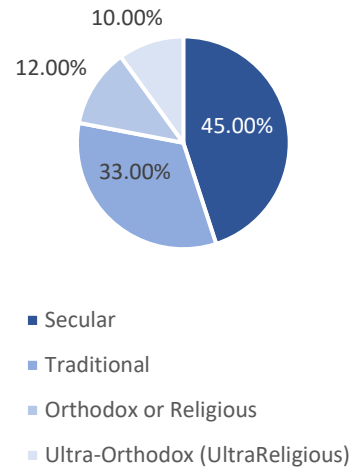

Self identification of Jewish belief association

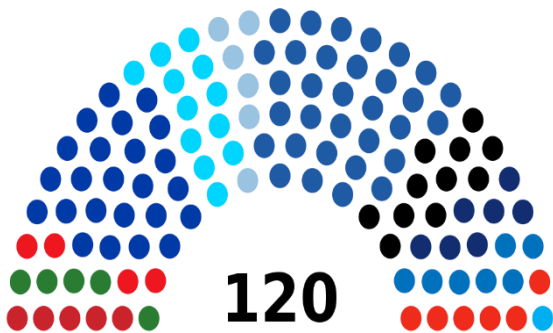


- Consider in the others category are faiths such as Samaritanism, Bahai, as well as unclassified religious affiliation.
- The Christian group encompass: Catholics, Eastern Orthodox, Anglicans, Christian Arabs, Protestants and Messianic Jews.
- Out of the 1.9% of people that identify as Christian, approximately 0.6% are Protestant.
- All the countries that surround Israel self-identify as 70%-90% Muslim.
- Israel is considered #2 in the list of the top ten religious' countries in the world.

- Jerusalem is often a point of contention as the area of the Temple Mount is considered a holy site by Jews, Christians, and Muslims.

F. Government

1. Government type – Parliamentary Democratic
2. Government branches:
 1. **Executive Branch** - include the chief of state (president), the head of the government (Prime Minister, most influential role in the nation), Cabinet (selected by prime minister and approved by the Knesset)
 2. **Legislative** - unicameral Knesset (120 seats; members directly elected in nationwide election; members serve 4-year term.
 3. **Judicial - Supreme Court** (consists of the president, deputy president, 13 justices, and 2 registrars). The judges are selected by the 9-member Judicial Selection Committee, consisting of the Minister of Justice, the president of the Supreme Court, two other justices, 1 Cabinet minister, 2 Knesset members, and 2 representatives of the Israel Bar Association.
3. The country has no formal constitution, for most things is taken into consideration the laws according to the Declaration of Establishment (1948), the Basic Laws, and the Law of Return. Amendments to this are to be proposed by ministers or by the Knesset and require the majority vote of the Knesset and judicial review of the Supreme Court

G. Health

- ④ Main causes of death are Cancer, Heart Diseases, Diabetes, Cerebrovascular Disease, Accidents, Suicide and^{iv}
- ④ Cancer and accidents are the leading cause of death of children.
- ④ Life expectancy for men 80.7 and women 84.8.
- ④ 16.4% self-identify as smokers.
- ④ Doctors in health services 3.3 per 1,000 citizens
- ④ Nurses employed in health services 4.8 per 1,000 citizens.
- ④ Although 90.3% of the population identifies as been satisfied with life, about half of the adult population experience mental health problems. Among the most recurrent anxiety disorders and depression. ^v
- ④ 19.9% frequently feel stressed.
- ④ 19.1% frequently or occasionally feel lonely.
- ④ 73% of teenagers report mental health problems or crisis and the cases increased during the pandemic.^{vi,vii}

H. Communications

- ④ 70% of all people over age 20 have used a computer.
- ④ 90.1 of all people over age 20 use the internet
- ④ 85.8% of the population use the internet via mobile phone.
- ④ 90.5% of the Jewish population use the internet.
- ④ 88.6% of the Arab population use the internet.
- ④ 85.5% of internet users report using the web every day.
- ④ 85.7% of the internet use is focused on discussion groups and social networks.



I. Current Issues

1. Judicial Reform/Civil Unrest - there are current government projects to reform the powers of the Supreme Court and the designation of its members. The proposed changes had caused civil unrest that has led to the manifestations of thousands of people in the streets and fears of civil unrest. ^{viii, ix, x}
2. Iran's capacity to enrich uranium to the level necessary for the development of nuclear bombs has exponentially increase. Several reports claim they will reach the level by April-May 2023, some even say they have enough material to develop 5 bombs. Iran has publicly vowed to eradicate Israel. ^{xi, xii, xiii}
3. Illicit Drugs: there is an increasing concern about ecstasy, cocaine, and heroine abuse; drugs arriving from Lebanon and Jordan. Recent studies claim that Israel is facing spike in the use fentanyl and is considered now the number 1 opioid consumer per capita in the world. ^{xiv}
4. Territory Disputes:
 - a) Israel-Gaza Strip – Territory that had been on dispute an currently control by Hamas militant resistance, which is a declared enemy of Israel as it does not recognize the government of Israel and has vowed to take control over the Region. Territory is often used to launch aerial attacks towards Israel.
 - b) Golan Heights – In 1981 Israel annexed the Golan Heights, the area has more then 30 settlements and an estimated amount of 20,000 Israeli live in the region in addition to 20, 000 Syrian, Druze and Arabs that did not fleet the region when it was captured. However, the international community with the exception of USA does not recognize Israel to have authority over the region.
 - c) West Bank – is considered by international community as Israeli-occupied with current status subject to the Israeli-Palestinian Interim Agreement. It has become a hot topic as Israel has continued the expansion of settlements in the region that Palestinians claim to have control over.



5. Attempt to penalize the people trying to convert others into their religion. There was a recent attempt to pass a law that would penalize those reaching out to others in an attempt to convert them to their religious beliefs, the proposed penalty was of one year of jail. The attempt was mostly focus in response to an increase of evangelicals trying to reach others in Israel. ^{xv}
6. Attacks and rejection of the Christians communities. Many articles coincide with stories from the past months were Christian churches and Christians in general have experience an increase in attacks against them and their institutions. ^{xvi, xvii, xviii,}
