## MINISTERIAL ORDINANCE

### Ministry of Education Ordinance No. 35

1. The sardines which are mentioned in the present list denote "Maiwashi" "Urume-iwashi" and "Katakuchiiwashi." "Sardine dried wholly" includes salt dried ones such as "Hohozashi" "Ren-zashi" "Mezashi," and "Hiraki-hoshi" (dried flat). "Sardines boiled and dried of improved quality" mean boiled and dried sardines which are shaped up by pressure for oil extraction.
2. The boiled and dried sardine as mentioned in the present list does not include boiled and dried "Chirimen" sardine and boiled and dried oil sardine. The controlled prices of sardine dried wholly, salt sardine and salted sardine, when mackerels, the length of which is smaller than 5 *sun*, are mixed with them, shall be those prices of the corresponding classifications and the controlled price of sardine boiled and dried shall be applied to that of "Iwashi-bushi."
3. The controlled selling prices of manufacturer are those for manufacturers and fishing associations and shall be either ex inspection office inspecting those articles hereby listed of prefectures and associations designated by the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry of prefectural governors, or ex collecting place of fishing associations.
4. The controlled selling prices of Central Fisheries are for delivery f.o.r. the nearest station, or f.o.b. the nearest port, to the business office of the Good Receiving Organization to be stipulated by a local Governor (In case of sale of improved, boiled and dried sardine to purchasers of large lot, delivery is to be effected to the business office of the purchasers of large lot or a place like the above). However, in case of sale of the boiled and dried sardine, and the improved-boiled-dried sardine as raw material to be processed for "Kezuri bushi,"

- the controlled prices are for delivery ex store of the purchaser, or ex factory.
5. The controlled selling prices of the wholesaler in the present list are for delivery ex store of the seller.
  6. The controlled prices of the present list are for goods of superior quality, and the controlled prices for ordinary quality shall be amounts 10% less than the controlled prices of the present list.
  7. The controlled prices of the present list are for those goods which are in accord with the standard of this list, and the controlled prices for those which do not correspond with the standard of this list and those dried whole sardine in a half-drystate in the term from April to September, shall be subject to the controlled prices of fresh "maiwashi."
  8. The controlled prices of the present list are for those which have passed the inspection to be conducted by Metropolis and Prefectures, or bodies designated by the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry, or local Governor, carrying a certificate or seal to that effect on the package, or receptacle (except in case of retail), and the controlled prices for those which do not carry the certificate shall be subject to the controlled prices of fresh "maiwashi."
  9. In this notification the length of fish is meant the length from the mouth to the tip of the tail-fin.
  10. The controlled prices of the present list include the wrapping and packing charges. However, when a re-packing is made with straw mat of boiled and dried sardine and "gomame" in paper bags, ¥15.00 per 10 "kan" can be added to the controlled prices of the present list.
  11. The controlled selling prices of producer in the

present list are for those produced in Metropolis and Prefectures, and the controlled prices for those produced in Hokkaido shall be amounts 5% less than the controlled prices for goods produced in Metropolis and Prefectures.

The following aids to navigation have been altered their character of lights, resumed, washed away or put out the lights respectively.

1. The Nojima Saki lighthouse at the south coast of Honshu, which had been lighted a temporary white fixed lantern, has been resumed since November 12, 1946, as follows:

Class: Third class.

Light character: White group flashing light (flashing twice every ten seconds at intervals of thirty seconds).

Light Power: Three hundred and thirty thousand (330,000) candle power.

Other details are as same as before.

2. The Tsuruga Port breakwater lighthouse at the end of Kanega Saki breakwater of Tsuruga Port at the north-west coast of Honshu has been altered its light character as a white flashing light, flashing every five seconds since November 8, 1946.
3. Both the Kurushima Shiraishi light beacon and Uzuhana lighthouse at the Kurushima Straits in the Inland Sea of Seto, which had been put out the lights by impediments, have been resumed since November 10, 1946.
4. The Ryujin Shima lighthouse at the Kurushima Straits in the Inland Sea of Seto, which had been put out the light by an impediment, has been resumed since November 11, 1946.
5. The Oita Port north breakwater lighthouse at Oita Port in the western part of the Inland Sea of Seto has been put out the light by an impediment since November 5, 1946.
6. The Ose light bouy in Nanao Bay at the north-west coast of Honshu has been washed away by wind and waves since November 8, 1946.
