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CABINET ORDINANCE

Cabinet Ordinance No. 89

December 26, 1946

The Enforcement Regulations for the Price Control Ordinance are partially revised as follows:

Prime Minister

YOSHIDA Shigeru

In Art. 2, par. 1, Art. 4 and Art. 5, par. 1, "Director-General of the Price Board (Director of Local Price Bureau of the Price Board, or Local Governor, in case the Director-General of the Price Board provides in particular)" shall read "Director-General of the Price Board (Director of the Local Price Bureau of the Price Board, or Local Governor, in case the Director of Local Price Bureau of the Price Board, or Local Governor is to take action in accordance with the provisions of Art. 11)".

In Art. 8, "the Ministry of Commerce & Industry Ordinance No. 17 of 1946 (concerning the inspection and their collection of silk fabrics and silk knit goods)" shall be added next to "Taxation of "Sake" Law"; "the Nihon Fertilizer Company, Ltd., Law" shall be added next to "the Nihon Agricultural Products Export Company, Ltd., Law"; and "the Law for Increasing Production of Ammonium Sulphate and its control of Distribution" shall be deleted.

Next to Art. 8-(2), the following items shall be added:

4. In case under provisions of Art. 15, Art. 19, and Art. 20 of the Alcohol Monopoly Law, the Director-General of the Price Board and Minister of Commerce and Industry.
5. In case under provisions of Art. 4 of the Ministry of Commerce and Industry Ordinance No. 17 of 1946 (concerning the inspection and their collection of silk fabrics and knit goods), as to those to be sold to the Government, the Director-General of the Price Board or Minister of Commerce and Industry.
6. In case under provisions of Art. 8, Art. 18 and Art. 19 of the Salt Monopoly Law, Director-General of the Price Board or Minister of Finance.
7. In case under provisions of Art. 3 and Art. 13 of the Crude Camphor, Camphor Oil Monopoly Law, the Director-General of the Price Board or Minister of Finance.
8. In case under provisions of Art. 6, Art. 25 and Art. 33-(5) of Tobacco Monopoly Law, the

Director-General of the Price Bureau or Minister of Finance.

Article 11. The competencies of the Director-General of the Price Board in the following respective items shall be exercised, by the Director of the Local Price Bureau as to the prices and the like prescribed by the Director-General of the Price Board so as to be dealt with by the Director of the Local Price Bureau; by the Local Governor as to the prices and the like prescribed by the Director-General of the Price Board so as to be dealt with by the Local Governor; or by chiefs of other local government offices as to the prices and the like prescribed by the Director-General of the Price Board so as to be dealt with by chiefs of other local government offices:

1. Approval in accordance with the proviso of Art. 3, par. 1 of the Price Control Ordinance.
2. Designation in accordance with Art. 4 of the Price Control Ordinance.
3. Sanction in accordance with Art. 5 of the Price Control Ordinance.
4. Disposal in accordance with Art. 5, par. 3 of the Price Control Ordinance.
5. Decision, order, approval, sanction or other disposal to be conducted as to the prices and the like in accordance with other laws or ordinances as provided under Art. 7 of the Price Control Ordinance in accordance with par. 2 of the Supplementary Provisions of the Imperial Ordinance No. 382 of 1946.

Of the price and the like so provided by the Director-General of the Price Board in accordance with the preceding paragraph that the Director of the Local Price Bureau shall dispose of, the price and the like so provided by the Director of the Local Price Bureau that Local Governors or chiefs of other local government offices shall dispose of shall be conducted by local Governors or chiefs of other local government offices.

Article 12. As to the special rule as mentioned in the provisions of Art. 7, par. 2, of the Price Control Ordinance, in case the Director-General of the Price Board provides so that local Governors, or chiefs, of other local government offices shall prescribe such a special rule, local Governors or chiefs of other local government offices shall prescribe the same.

Article 13. The local Governor as mentioned in the present Regulations shall include the Super-

intendent-General of the Metropolitan Police in the case of Tokyo Metropolis.

Supplementary Provision:

The present Cabinet Ordinance shall come into force as from the day of its promulgation.

MINISTERIAL ORDINANCE

Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry Ordinance No. 73

December 26, 1946

The following partial amendments shall be made to the Regulations concerning Subsidies to Agricultural Land Adjustment Works:

Minister of Agriculture and Forestry

WADA Hiroo

Article 2. The subsidies shall be granted to Tokyo Metropolis, Hokkaido, a Special Prefecture or Prefecture, or the Central Cooperative Bank of Agriculture and Forestry, the Hypothec Bank of Japan or the Hokkaido Colonial Bank (hereinafter referred to as "the financial institutions") for the following expenses or subsidies:

1. The expenses of Tokyo Metropolis, Hokkaido, a Special Prefecture or Prefecture requisite for the decision or arbitration made by the Agricultural Land Commission of the same in accordance with the provisions of the Owner-Farmer Establishment Special Measures Law;
2. The expenses of Tokyo Metropolis, Hokkaido, a Special Prefecture or Prefecture requisite for the Agricultural Land Commission of the same (exclusive of those mentioned in the preceding item) and the subsidies to be granted by Tokyo Metropolis, Hokkaido, a Special Prefecture or Prefecture to a City, Town or Village for the expenses of its Agricultural Land Commission;
3. The expenses of Tokyo Metropolis, Hokkaido, a Special Prefecture or Prefecture requisite for business concerning agricultural land;
4. The fund for the establishment and maintenance of owner-farmers or the fund for the promotion and encouragement of the establishment of owner-farmer as required by Tokyo Metropolis, Hokkaido, a Special Prefecture or Prefecture, or by the financial institutions;
5. Subsidies to be granted by Tokyo Metropolis, Hokkaido, a Special Prefecture or Prefecture to a City, Town or Village, or the Agricultural Land Commission of Tokyo Metropolis, Hokkaido, a Special Prefecture or Prefecture, the Agricultural Land Commission of a City, Town or Village, industrial cooperative associations ('sangyo-kumiai'), farming practice associations, the Agricultural Land Development Corporation or other associations organized by persons engaging in cultivation and designated by the prefectural governor, for the funds requisite for their works for the establishment

and maintenance of owner-farmers, or for their funds for the promotion and encouragement of the establishment of owner-farmers;

6. Subsidies to be granted by Tokyo Metropolis, Hokkaido, a Special Prefecture or Prefecture to the agricultural association of a City, Town or Village, or to other associations recognized by the prefectural governor as suitable, for the expenses requisite for their works for the establishment and maintenance of owner-farmers.

As regards the expenses or subsidies mentioned in items 3 and 7, subsidies may be granted not only to persons mentioned in the said items, but also to those recognized by the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry as suitable.

In Art. 3, "or item 5" shall be added after "item 4 of the preceding Article;" "the agricultural association of Tokyo Metropolis, Hokkaido, a Special Prefecture or Prefecture" shall be added after "a City, Town or Village;" "item 4 of the said Article" shall read "item 5 of the said Article;" "or farming practice associations" shall read "farming practice associations, the Agricultural Land Development Corporation or associations organized by persons engaging in cultivation and designated by the prefectural governor;" and "Arts. 11 and 12 of the Regulations for the Enforcement of the Agricultural Land Adjustment Law" shall read "Arts. 4 and 5 of the Regulations for the Enforcement of the Agricultural Land Adjustment Law."

Supplementary Provisions:

The present Ordinance shall come into force as from the day of its promulgation.

With regard to those who have, prior to the enforcement of the present Ordinance, received a direction on the granting of a subsidy, the old provisions shall remain applicable.

Article 1. Revenue Stamp appearing in the forms of No.

1 to No. 4, and Revenue Stamp appearing in the forms

of No. 5 and No. 6 of the Regulation pertaining to Authorization of Electric Metering Instruments shall be abolished, and the words "the amount of attached revenue stamp" appearing in the forms of No. 1 to No. 6 of the same Regulations shall be revised to "application fee."

Article 2. Revenue Stamp appearing in the form A of

the Matters pertaining to Electric Metering Instruments to be examined by the Public Community or the Public Welfare Juridical Person shall be abolished, and the words "the amount of attached revenue stamp" appearing therein shall be revised to "application fee."

Article 3. The Matters pertaining to Payment of Fee for Authorization of Electric Metering Instruments shall be abolished.

Article 4. The Electric Appliances Control Regulations shall be partially revised as follows :

The following one paragraph shall be added to paragraph 2 of Article 21. "The fee designated under preceding each paragraph shall be paid by attaching on respective application revenue stamp equivalent to the amount thereof."

Article 23 shall be deleted.

Revenue Stamp appearing in the forms of No. 3

and No. 4 shall be abolished, and words "the amount of attached revenue stamp" shall be revised to "application fee."

Supplementary Provision :

The present Ministerial Ordinance shall be applied as from September 13, 1946.

INSTRUCTIONS

Gabinet Instruction No. 13

December 26, 1946

To Each Ministry :

In accordance with the provisions of paragraph 2, Article 1 of the Ordinance of Economic Stabilization Board, regulations concerning the restrictions of buildings and installations shall be decided as follows :

Prime Minister

YOSHIDA Shigeru

Restrictions concerning Buildings and Installations

Article 1. The purpose of the regulations is to restrict the non-essential construction of any buildings (including new buildings, extension of buildings, moving of buildings, conversion of buildings and/or changing of buildings), alteration of using purpose or installation, reparation, conversion or transfer of machineries, equipments and facilities, in order to secure the production materials designated by the appended list of Cabinet Instruction No. 10 dated on November 20th, 1946 (hereafter called designated materials) and to appropriate those materials to the most imminent use.

Article 2. The competent Ministry shall provide regulations to realize the purpose of the preceding Article founded upon the Temporary Demand Supply Adjustment Act according to the procedures mentioned as follows :

1) Any person who commences actions mentioned below shall submit the application, of which form will be notified later on, to the competent Ministry :

a) Construction of buildings or alteration of using purpose of buildings ;

b) Installation, reparation or conversion of equipments mentioned in Clause 1 of the appended list, provided that the cases where no designated materials are used may be exempted ;

c) Installation, conversion receiving delivery

or borrowing machines and/or equipments mentioned in Clause 2 of the appended list or machinery establishments consisting of machines and/or equipments mentioned in Clause 3 of the appended list, provided that the cases of receiving delivery by those who engage in sale of the said machines and/or equipments may be exempted;

- d) Receiving delivery or borrowing machines and/or equipments mentioned in Clause 3 of the appended list, provided that the cases of receiving delivery by those who are engaging in sale of the said machines and/or equipments may be exempted;
 - e) Selling of machines and/or equipments mentioned in Clause 2 or 3 of the appended list by persons who are not in the business of selling the said machines and/or equipments;
 - f) Operation of machinery establishments consisting of machines and/or equipments mentioned in Clause 3 of the appended list, provided that the cases coming under the sub-paragraph c) may be exempted.
- 2) In case any person of the preceding Clause requires the allotment of materials, he shall present allotment application of materials or allocation certificates appended with the application form of the preceding Clause.
 - 3) The provisions of Clause 1 shall be applied to persons who do not require purchasing any materials.
 - 4) Any person who is not satisfied with application of the regulations may appeal to Economic Stabilization Board stating the clear reason. In this case, he shall transfer the copy to the competent Ministry.

Article 3. The competent office for this regulation shall be Economic Stabilization Board for public works (which are to be authorized by Economic Stabilization Board) and the Board of Reconstruction for all other constructions.

Article 4. Imperial Ordinance No. 288 of 1946 concerning Temporary Construction Restrictions shall be abrogated.
