# MINISTERIAL ORDINANCE

# Ministry of Justice Ordinance No. 56

June 23, 1947

The following amendments shall be made to a part of the Procedure of the Registration of the Special Accounting Companies and the Others:

#### Minister of Justice SUZUKI Yoshio

In Art. 1, the words "the Law concerning the Emergency Measures for the Accounts of Companies and the Imperial Ordinance relating to the enforcement of the same Law" shall read "the Law concerning the Emergency Measures for the Accounts of Companies, the Imperial Ordinance relating to the enforcement of the same Law, the Financial Institutions Reconstruction and Reorganization Law, the Enterprise Reconstruction and Reorganization Law, the Unlimited Partnership and the Others Reconstruction and Reorganization Imperial Ordinance," and the word "association" shall read "financial institution."

In Art. 3, Par. 1, the words "under Par. 3 of Art. 28 of the Law concerning the Emergency Measures for the Accounts of Financial Institutions" shall read "under the Law concerning the Emergency Measures for the Accounts of Financial Institutions and the Financial Institutions Reconstruction and Reorganization Law," and the word "association" shall read "financial institution."

In Art. 4, Par. 1, "the Enterprise Reconstruction and Reorganization Law and the Unlimited Partnership and the Others Reconstruction and Reorganization Imperial Ordinance" shall be added after the words "the Imperial Ordinance relating to the enforcement of the same Law," and "or liquidator" shall be added after the word "director." In Art. 5, Par. 2, "other of cials administering

In Art. 5, Par. 2, "other officials administering affairs" shall be added after the work "directer," and "(an official administering affairs in juristic person designated by the competent Minister prescribed in Art. 15, Par. 2 of the Imperial Ordinance relating to the Enforcement of the Law concerning the Emergency Measures for the Accounts of Companies)" shall be added after the words "their representative."

Article 5-2. Financial Institutions mentioned in Art. 27, Item 2 of the Law concerning the Emergency Measures for the Accounts of Financial Institutions shall strike out the registration prescribed in Art. 28, Par. 2 of the said Law within the period specified in Art. 34, Par. 3 of the Financial Institutions Reconstruction and Reorganization Law.

Article 5-3. The company, mentioned in Art. 1, Par. 1, Item 2, (Ro) and (Ha) of the Law concerning the Emergency Measures for the Accounts of Companies, of which capital (the total amount of the contribution or that of the share capital or the total sum of these two amounts) is more than  $\frac{1}{2}200,000$  shall strike out the registration prescribed in Art. 3 of the said Law within the period specified in Art. 42, Par. 2 of the Enterprise Reconstruction and Reorganization Law.

Article 9. The provisions of Arts. 6 and 8 shall apply with the necessary modifications to the registration mentioned in the latter part of Art. 37, Par. 1 of the Enterprise Reconstruction and Reorganization Law (including the case in which it shall apply with the necessary modifications in Art. 2 of the Unlimited Partnership and the Others Reconstruction and Reorganization Imperial Ordinance).

Supplementary Provision:

This Ministerial Ordinance shall come into force as from the day of its promulgation.

## Ministry of Justice Ordinance No. 57

June 23, 1947

The following partial amendment shall be made to "concerning the commission of registration business of the Mito Judicial Bureau and its Branches within its jurisdiction":

Paragraph 7 in Article 1 shall be deleted.

Supplementary Provision:

The present Ministerial Ordinance shall come into force as from July 1, 1947.

# INSTRUCTIONS

#### Ministry of Finance Instructions No. 8

June 23, 1947

To Directors of the Regional Financial:

Directors of the Regional Financial Bureaus shall only be authorized to give approvals provided for in Paragraph 4 of Article 12 and Paragraph 2 of Article 31 of the Enforcement Ordinance for the Law concerning the Special Measures for the Establishment of Landed Farmers regarding miscellaneous properties under the jurisdiction of the Ministry of Finance.

Sales terms:

1. Sales of paper having quality other than those given in the present list shall not be made. In case such sales are inevitable, approval of the Director-General of Price Board must be obtained;

2. The controlled prices of producer shall be f.o.r. arriving station ex pier of the arriving port, or warehouse, to be stipulated by the wholesaler;

3. The controlled prices of wholesaler shall be ex store, or warehouse of the wholesaler;

- 4. The controlled prices of retailer shall be ex store of the retailer;
- 5. The controlled prices of this list shall include a commodity tax as to those on which such tax is levied by the Commodity Tax Law. However, in case such commodity tax is exempted amount which is equal to the amount of tax shall be deducted from the controlled prices;
- 6. The weight for the controlled prices given in the present list shall be net.

The Articles of Incorporation of the Industrial Reconstruction Kodan

#### Chapter I

#### General Provisions

- Article 1. The Kodan shall be established in accordance with the provisions of the Industrial Reconstruction Kodan Law, and called the Industrial Reconstruction Kodan.
- Article 2. The Kodan shall have, for its object, the adjustment and utilization of industrial equipment and materials in order to facilitate the rehabilitation of post-war industry under the basic industrial policies and plans to be set up by the Director-General of the Economic Stabilization Board.
- Article 3. The main office of the Kodan shall be established in Tokyo.

The Kodan may, with the approval of the Minister of Commerce and Industry, establish branch offices where essential for the business mentioned in Article 12.

The Kodan may, establish sub-branch offices in other localities as deemed suitable for business.

Article 4. All public notices of the Kodan shall be published in the Official Gazette or The Nipon Keizai.

## Chapter II

#### Capital

Article 5. The authorized fixed capital of the Kodan shall be ¥200,000,000 to be subscribed exclusively by Government.

Working capital shall be obtained by loan when necessary from the Reconstruction Finance Bank.

#### Chapter III

#### Officers and Employees

- Article 6. The Kodan shall have as its officers, one President, one Vice-president, two or more Directors and one or more Auditors.
- Article 7. The President shall represent the Kodan and supervise its business in accordance with the provisions of Article 16 of the Industrial Reconstruction Kodan Law.

The Vice-president shall, as will be determined by the President, represent the Kodan, assist the President in conducting business, act for him in case he cannot take his duty, and preform his function in case his post becomes vacant.

The Directors shall, as will be determined by the President, represent the Kodan, assist the President and Vice-president in control of its affairs.

The Directors shall, in such order as prearranged by the President, act for the President and Vice-president in case they cannot take their duties and perform their functions in case their positions become vacant.

In case the President has given the Vice-president or the Directors the authority of representation in accordance with the provisions of the preceding three (3) paragraphs, he shall make public notice of the extent of the authority of representation.

The Auditors shall inspect the business of the Kodan.

- Article 8. The President, Vice-president, Directors and Auditors shall be appointed by the Minister of Commerce and Industry.
- Article 9. The President, Vice-president and Directors may, as will be determined by the President, delegate power to officers and employees of the Kodan who shall have authority to perform all juridical and non-juridical matters in regard to the affairs of the main or branch offices.
- Article 10. The officers and employees of the Kodan shall not be permitted to be stockholders or employees or to have any beneficial interest in any company or enterprise which acquire the lease of industrial equipments or materials from the Kodan.
- Article 11. The officers and employees of the Kodan shall be government officials and employees in accordance with the provisions of Article 15 of the Industrial Reconstruction Kodan Law.

#### Chapter IV

# Business and its Execution

- Article 12. The Kodan shall perform, under the direction and supervision of the Minister of Commerce and Industry, the following business in conformity with the basic industrial policies and programs to be established by the Director-General of the Economic Stabilization Board:
  - 1. Construction, and lease or sale of industrial equipments under the program to be established by the Director-General of the Economic Stabilization Board;
  - 2. Purchase, and lease or sale of industrial equipment or materials, under the program to be established by the Director-General of he Economic Stabilization Board;

- 3. Enterprises designated by the Director-General of the Economic Stabilization Board, other than those listed in above items.
- Article 13. The Kodan at the commencement of its functioning shall establish its method of doing business and submit the same to the Director-General of the Economic Stabilization Board for his approval.

This shall also apply where a change is to be made thereto.

- Article 14. The Kodan shall, at the beginning of the first and the second term of each business year, establish a business program and financial program for every six months and submit the same to the Director-General of the Economic Stabilization Board for his approval. This shall also apply where a change is to be made thereto.
- Article 15. Rules and regulations governing execution of business shall be established by the President.

#### Chapter V

#### Accounts

- Article 16. The business year of the Kodan shall be from April each year to March of the following year and divided into the first term and the second term.
- Article 17. The Kodan shall prepare a statement of assets, a balance sheet and a statement of profit and loss for each term of the preceding Article, and submit them to the Director-General of the Economic Stabilization Board, for his approval within two months after the conclusion of the business year.

The Kodan shall, when it has obtained the approval prescribed in the 1st paragraph make a public notice of the statement of assets, balance sheet and the statement of the profit and loss and keep them together with the Articles of Incorporation in each office.

The statement of assets, balance sheet and statement of profit and loss of the preceding paragraph shall be verified and audited by the Board of Audit.

Article 18. The Kodan shall, when it has obtained the approval of the Director-General of the Economic Stabilization Board, pay to the National Treasury the entire profit as determined by the Stipulation of the Ordinance.

#### Chapter VI

# Alteration of Articles of Incorporation

Article 19. Any alteration to the Articles of Incorporation is subject to the approval of the Minister of Commerce and Industry and the Director-General of the Economic Stabilization Board.
