## **Gemunder Center Policy Internships**

The Gemunder Center seeks research interns to contribute to the work of its professional staff and task forces. The position will consist primarily in collaborating with senior policy staff and JINSA's executive director on rigorous, in-depth research for JINSA's Iran Strategy Council and the Iran Task Force.

The Iran Strategy Council is an organization of former top senior military officials and defense analysts with the mission of educating audiences on the Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action (JCPOA) and how it will make the United States and its allies less safe and war with Iran and its proxies more likely. JINSA's Gemunder Center Iran Task Force brings together former high-ranking government and military officials, energy experts and business leaders to address the challenges to U.S. national security of Iran's pursuit of nuclear weapons capability. The task force will examine the strategic, economic, and military options available to the United States and develop a robust U.S. strategy to prevent a nuclear Iran.

Research interns are also likely to research other national security related issues that advance JINSA's mission of advocating for a robust U.S. national security and supporting Israel and other like-minded allies.

- Ability to analyze developments related to Middle East security issues using open-source materials.
- Strong research, writing and editing skills are a must.
