

Not only do they include a variety of engaging stories within the skill set for this level, they also include level-aligned comprehension activities. Students will benefit from using these leveled passages in the following ways:

- Whole group
- Small group
- In tutoring
- As a guided homework activity
- Independently *(if passage is below the student's independent reading level)

The following components have been incorporated based on the text and abilities of students reading within Level C.

- Use of high frequency words
- Pictures that support the text
- Multiple lines of text per page
- Simple comprehension questions based on the text (with multiple choice answers included)
- Simple inferential questions with multiple choice answers
