

Julian Roots Run Deep

For generations, this area was inhabited by Native Americans. In the mid-1800s, European settlers arrived. The Julian settlement was originally a mining camp, thanks to cattleman and former slave A.E. "Fred" Coleman, who in 1869, found

Julian may be home to some of the best apple pies in San Diego County, but its historical roots stretch even deeper than our famous apple trees.

> After the Civil War, Confederate veterans migrated to Julian in search of gold, and Drue Bailey and Mike Julian, two cousins from Georgia, were among them. In 1870, Bailey officially founded Julian City and christened it in honor of his cousin. Within two years, there were several hotels, stores and restaurants, in addition to a schoolhouse and saloons.

The mines in Julian and the Banner area yielded millions of dollars in gold ore. Today, visitors may take tours of an authentic mine.



While many mining towns blossomed and then turned into ghost towns, Julian survived, likely due to its agricultural potential and its location near San Diego.

It proved to be a rich land for crops and pasture animals. In the early 1870s, however, another seed of fame was planted when James Madison brought in a wagon load of young apple trees.

The climate and soil were perfect for such a venture, and Julian apples won blue ribbons at the 1893 San Francisco World's Fair and the 1915 Chicago World's Fair.

The American Pomological Society also awarded Julian apples the Bronze Wilder Medal at the 1907 Tricentennial Exposition in Jamestown, VA. More than a century later, visitors still flock to Julian in the fall for the apple harvests at local orchards and to enjoy freshly baked pies and apple cider.

Julian Pioneer Cemetery, which is open to the public, is the final resting place for many of these early pioneers. Today, the town is a designated Historic District, and the residents and shop owners delight in sharing its legacy.

HIT THE TRAILS

VOLCAN MOUNTAIN WILDERNESS PRESERVE

Surrounded by orchards, vineyards, woodlands and farms, Volcan Mountain is a sight to behold. With nearly 3,000 acres of mixed forest land, the preserve offers hikers a good dose of wilderness. There are different routes to take up the mountain, but Five Oaks Trail is specifically for hikers and provides more seclusion.

The view from the summit at 5,353 feet is well worth the effort. The hike totals just over five miles and is considered moderately strenuous. The trailhead for the summit is located at 1209 Farmer Rd. at Wynola Road. ■

Remember to prepare for your hike by packing a first aid kit and bringing enough food and water for the entire trip. Be sure to tell someone where you will be hiking and when you intend to return. And make sure to leave the trail better than you found it – pack out everything you bring in.

The Julian area's stunning backdrop of rolling foothills and seemingly untouched landscape make for an inspirational setting for backcountry hiking. These trails are sure to quench your craving for adventure.

STONEWALL PEAK


Cuyamaca Rancho State Park features a number of hiking trails and outdoor activities, but the view atop Stonewall Peak cannot be missed. This short, two-mile hike is sure get your heart rate going. And the 360-degree views from the summit at 5,730 feet are breathtaking.

To access the trail, park at Paso Picacho day use area at 13652 Highway 79. The trailhead is across the highway. Be sure to check for any trail closures before you visit and purchase a day-use pass.

WILLIAM HEISE COUNTY PARK

Hikers looking for a variety of trails are sure to enjoy William Heise County Park, located at 4945 Heise Park Rd. With more than 1,000 acres of land, the sprawling park offers plenty of space to stretch your legs. It's a choose-your-hike kind of place, from the one-mile Cedar Trail loop to the 5.75-mile Kelly Ditch Trail, which travels all the way to Lake Cuyamaca, and more.

The park is close to the town of Julian while feeling a world away. There are trail options for hikers, bikers and equestrians.




