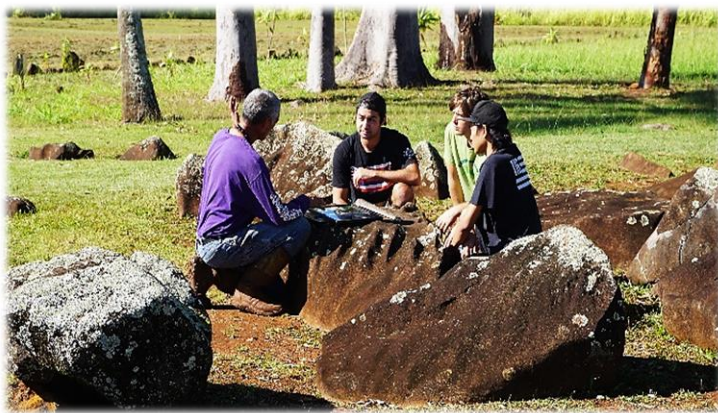

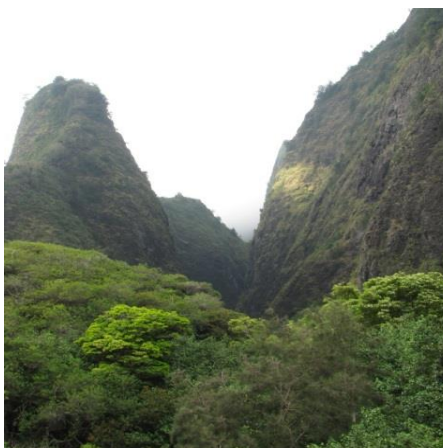
01.28.2k19 ... Koa Ridge Makai Development Program ...
