CHAPTER 527 - FORESTRY; FOREST PRODUCTS AND FLORA

Timber Trespass (NRS 527.010)

Cutting without written permission of landowner

Tree and Flora Protection (NRS 527.050)

- cut, destroy, mutilate, pick or remove
- tree, shrub, plant, fern, wild flower, cacti, desert or montane flora, or any seeds, roots or bulbs
- critically endangered plants require special permit

Christmas Trees, Cacti and Yucca Protection (NRS 527.070-.100)

- Commercial purposes requires permit (tags, shipping, harvesting)
- > 6 in possession per day or less for 7 consecutive days
- Exemption: maintenance of electric power lines, telephone lines or other property of a public utility, or to a logging operation. Tribal entities.

CHAPTER 527 - FORESTRY; FOREST PRODUCTS AND FLORA

List of Fully Protected Species (NRS 527.270)

- regarded by the State Forester as threatened with extinction
 - Over exploitation, disease, habitat threatened with destruction
- Listed on the list of fully protected species (NAC 527.010)
- no member may be removed or destroyed without a special permit
- 24 species
 - Forbs or half shrubs
 - High specialized to specific and rare soil and environmental conditions



CHAPTER 528 – FORESTRY PRACTICES

Definitions

- <u>Logging Operation</u> commercial harvesting of ... by felling, skidding, forwarding or yarding, onsite processing and loading of trees or logs onto trucks.
- <u>Timber owner</u> means a person or entity who owns a tree-dominated landscape which is naturally capable of supporting ... native trees in perpetuity, and is not otherwise devoted to non-forestry commercial or urban uses.



CHAPTER 528 – FORESTRY PRACTICES

Logging Permits and Restrictions (NRS 528.042-.080)

- required prior to any logging or cutting operation
 - application submitted
 - performance bond
 - erosion control, fire control, and stocking requirements



CHAPTER 528 – FORESTRY PRACTICES

Timberland Conversion Certificates (NRS 528.082-.090)

- required prior to any cutting operation
 - application submitted
 - performance bond
 - erosion control, fire control, slope restrictions and stocking requirements
