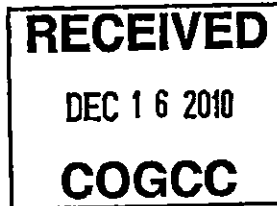

THE CAP (STEEL) MAY HAVE STRUCK A SPARK IGNITING THE GAS RELEASED BEHIND THE SITE GLASS. THE NORTH TREATER IN THE TWO TREATER SETUP WAS BURNED DESTROYING ITS INTERNAL ACCESSORIES. NO DAMAGE TO THE SECOND TREATER UNIT OCCURRED. NO DAMAGE TO THE ADJACENT AREA OF THE TANK BATTERY. THE CALGARY FIRE DEPT RESPONDED TO THE FIRE THIS CAPTAIN (A LOCAL MELTIE EMPLOYEE) CLOSED THE GAS VALVE TO THE TREATER AND THE FIRE EXTINGUISHED ITSELF.
