- 13 data; unlawful collection of resource data.

(a) A person commits a civil trespass to unlawfully 1 2 collect resource data if he: 3 4 (i) Enters onto open or crosses private land for the purpose of collecting resource data; and 5 6 7 (ii) Does not have: 8 (A) An ownership interest in the real 9 property or statutory, contractual or other legal 10 11 authorization to enter or access cross the private land to 12 collect the specified resource data; or 13 14 (B) Written or verbal permission of the owner, lessee or agent of the owner to enter or access 15 16 cross the private land to collect the specified resource 17 data. 18 19 (b) A person commits a civil trespass of unlawfully 20 collecting resource data if he enters onto or crosses 21 private open land and collects resource data without: 22

1	(i) An ownership interest in the real property
2	or, statutory, contractual or other legal authorization to
3	enter or cross the private land to collect the specified
4	resource data; or

6	(ii) Written or verbal permission of the owner,
7	lessee or agent of the owner to enter or cross the private
