

Three undergraduates maintain straight A grades

Three undergraduate students from the University of California, San Diego managed to pass the rigors of their first year of college study with straight "A" grades, it has been reported by Dr. Edward Goldberg, Provost of Revelle College.

Twenty-one other undergraduate students received honors in their first year of work by maintaining a grade point average of 3.5 or better. Straight "A" grades equal a grade point of 4. The 24 honor students, 11 women and 13 men, are members of the first undergraduate class ever to study at UCSD. A total of 181 freshmen began their studies at the Torrey Pines Mesa campus last fall.
