

For over 20 years, William H. Rastetter, Ph.D. has played a crucial role in establishing San Diego as a center for life sciences innovation. After graduating from MIT, Dr. Rastetter earned his doctorate in biochemistry from Harvard University and returned to MIT as an associate professor of chemistry. As biotechnology began to take its first steps, Dr. Rastetter joined Genentech, where he held several



leadership positions. However, it was his role as Director of Corporate Ventures that set the stage for his transition from scientist to entrepreneur and corporate executive. In 1986, Dr. Rastetter joined IDEC Pharmaceuticals as President and CEO and led the building of San Diego's premier biotechnology company and the development of Rituxan, the first monoclonal antibody in the fight against cancer. As Chairman and CEO of IDEC, he took the bold step of merging with Biogen, creating one of the world's largest biotechnology companies, Biogen Idec. Through his work as a business leader, scientist, teacher, and member of our community, Dr. Rastetter has made a significant impact on San Diego. For these contributions and his vision, compassion, and commitment to the advancement of biotechnology and the welfare of patients, we are honored to grant Dr. William H. Rastetter with our highest honor, membership into the CONNECT Entrepreneur Hall of Fame.





Since its inception in 1995, the program has featured more than 640

local leaders. "The Heart of San Diego" is seen on ITV, cable channel 16 on Monday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday at 8:30 pm, Saturday at 7:00 pm, Sundays at 5:00 pm, and is funded by the San Diego Foundation, Manchester Financial and Grand Resorts.

The recipient of a BA and two graduate degrees, Fred has taught radio, TV, and communications locally for more than 40 years at San Diego City College, UCSD, and National University. He continues to teach at "City" where he is a Professor Emeritus in the radio and TV department, and is the Sports Director on KSDS FM Jazz 88.
