IN THE MATTER OF LICENSE NO. 34018 ISSUED TO DANIEL JOHNSON, DDS

**NON-DISCIPLINARY REMEDIAL PLAN**

On August 11, 2023, this Remedial Plan was issued by the Texas State Board of Dental Examiners (Board) to resolve the above-referenced matter. This Remedial Plan is issued under the authority of Tex. Occ. Code § 263.0077 and based on the allegation that violations of the laws or rules regulating the practice of dentistry have occurred.

Daniel Johnson, DDS, holder of Texas Dental License No. 34018 (Respondent), appeared at an informal settlement conference on March 23, 2023, at 1801 Congress Ave., Suite 8.600, Austin, Texas. Respondent was represented by Tony Cobos. Dental Review Committee members Reena Shiralkar, DDS, and Danielle Franklin, DDS, represented the Board at the settlement conference and recommend this Remedial Plan to resolve this matter.

**Allegations**

Based on an investigation Board staff alleges that during the time period from April 8, 2019, through July 28, 2021, Respondent fell below the minimum standard of care in the treatment of a patient by failing to take a post-operative radiograph showing a clear view of cemented implant crown on tooth number 10 and failing to seat the crown on tooth number 10 flush to the custom abutment, leaving a circumferential open margin. During the same time period, Respondent failed to make, maintain, and keep treatment records for the patient. Specifically, Respondent failed to include patient's vitals at multiple treatment appointments, including prior to administration of local anesthesia on April 8, 2019, April 9, 2019, May 9, 2019, May 3, 2021, and June 17, 2021; amendments of chart notes in a clinically acceptable time period; or an explanation why these items were not included. Lastly, during the time period from October 19, 2021, through October 21, 2021, Respondent committed unprofessional and dishonorable conduct by altering entries in the patient's treatment notes more than a year after the date of treatment following receiving notice of a Board complaint. These allegations represent grounds for discipline under 22 Tex. Admin Code §§ 108.7(1), (2), 108.8(b)(4), (5), (c)(2)(A), (5), (12), 108.9(6), (11).

**Requirements**

1. Within sixty (60) days of the date of issuance of this Remedial Plan by the Board, Respondent SHALL provide proof to the Compliance Division of the Board sufficient to show the successful completion of twelve (12) hours of pre-approved continuing education courses, six (6) hours of which shall be in the area of Implants and six (6) hours of which shall be in the area Risk Management and Record Keeping. Courses that are not pre-approved are presumed insufficient.
2. Within sixty (60) days of the date of issuance of this Remedial Plan by the Board, Respondent SHALL remit a five hundred dollar (\$500.00) check or money order to the Board to recover the costs of administering this Remedial Plan.
3. Within sixty (60) days of the date of the issuance of this Remedial Plan by the Board, Respondent SHALL take and pass the Jurisprudence Assessment - Dentists (No sedation permits).
4. Failure to comply with the requirements of this Remedial Plan may result in disciplinary action against Respondent's license.

**Acknowledgement**

I, Daniel Johnson, DDS, have read and understand the foregoing Remedial Plan, and I agree to its requirements. I neither admit nor deny the allegations made in this Remedial Plan. I voluntarily waive my right to a formal adjudicatory hearing to contest this matter, and I acknowledge that this Remedial Plan is final and non-appealable.
