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On classes defining a homological dimension

A class \mathcal{F} of objects of an abelian category \mathcal{A} is said to define a *homological dimension* if for any object in \mathcal{A} the length of any \mathcal{F} -resolution is uniquely determined. In this talk we investigate classes satisfying this property.
