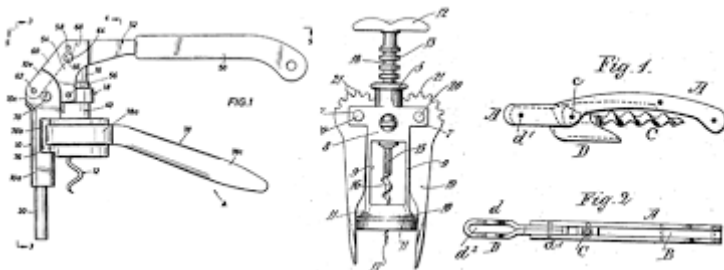

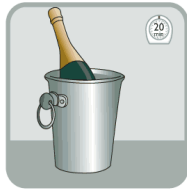

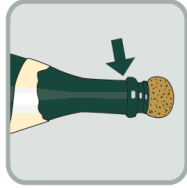
# O.G. of BUBBLES..... CHAMPAGNE



Wipe away any excess moisture.



Untwist the wire; remove the cage.



Locate where the seam meets the lip.



Swipe forward in one fast motion.



The spray washes away any shards.

## HOW TO SABER A BOTTLE OF CHAMPAGNE

**Step 1.** Choose your bottle.

**Step 2.** Choose your tool. (It's not the size of your tool, it's how you use it!)

**Step 3.** Take a few deep breaths and calm your nerves.

**Step 4.** You've GOT THIS!! (Say this quietly under your breath)

**Step 5.** Follow the directions of your Wine Captain.

**Step 6.** Bask in the glory of sabering your first bottle.

**Step 7.** Drink Champagne!

**POL ROGER BRUT NV**

“Pol Roger has been making Champagne since 1849, and has just recently unearthed a treasure trove of bottles that had been lost when two floors of the cellars collapsed on February 23<sup>rd</sup> 1900. Le Vigneron Champenois reported “at about two o’clock in the morning, a dull rumble similar to the sound of thunder awoke Maurice Roger and his chef de cave out of slumber”. Huge parts of the cellar had caved in as well as many adjoining buildings. The house of Pol Roger lost over 1.5 million bottles and 500 casks. The lost but now found vintages are anywhere between 1887 and 1898. They aren’t just found bottles, they’re a symbol of tenacity, struggle and ultimately triumph.” -Amy

We were hosts of the Hugel family for a whirlwind tour of the region and vineyards. After a 6-course dinner in a restaurant that seated us at the last minute, (the original one refused to serve us as we were so late and possibly a little drunk) Jean-Frederick took us on a midnight stroll around Riquewihr. With Hugel Eau-de-Vie’s in hand, we walked around the empty streets of this charming town and learned not just about its history, but about the Hugel family and how they and their wine have survived generation after generation. – Amy

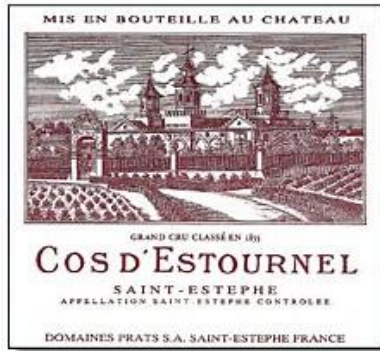

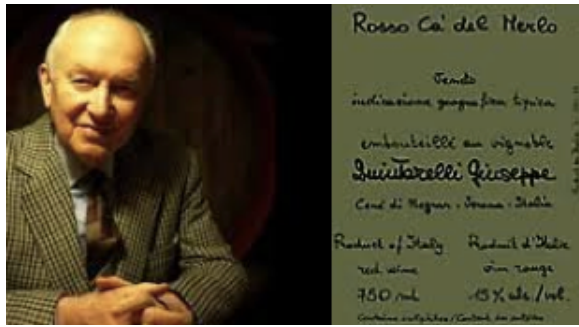

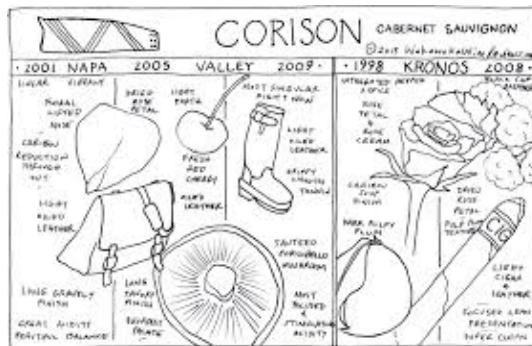
