3. Phytosanitary measures

- Importation of the host plants from the prohibited areas is prohibited.
- Additional declaration (“The shipment was inspected and found free of *Phytophthora ramorum*”) on phytosanitary certificate is required for the importation of;
 - Host plants and/or associated plants from the regulated areas
 - Associated plants from the prohibited areas
- And in case of USA, the name of State and County is required on PC as additional declaration
