## MINUTA

### PORTARIA Nº

Establishes Phytosanitary Requirements for the imports of delphinium seeds (*Delphinium* spp) from any origin.

The Secretary the Secretariat of Animal and Plant Health, of the Ministry of Agriculture, Livestock and Supply, in the use of the rights conferred on him by arts. 24 and 68 of Annex I of Decree No. 10,827, of September 30, 2021, in view of the provisions of Decree No. 24,114, of April 12, 1934, in Decree No. 1,355, of December 30, 1994, in Decree No. 5,759, of April 17, 2006, in MAPA Ordinance No. 65, of March 30, 2021, in Normative Instruction No. 25, of April 7, 2020, and that contained in Process No. 21000.039625/2021-74, resolves:

Art. 1º The phytosanitary requirements for the imports of seeds (Category 4) of delphinium (*Delphinium* spp), of any origin, are hereby established.

Art. 2º The seeds must be packed in first-use packages and free from soil.

Art. 3º The seeds must be accompanied by a Phytosanitary Certificate issued by the National Plant Protection Organization - NPPO of the country of origin, with the following Additional Declaration:

I - "The consignment is free from *Mycocentrospora acerina* according to the result of the official analysis of laboratory No. ( )".

Art. 4º According to the phytosanitary status in its territory, the country of origin may, alternatively, declare:

I - "The fungus *Mycocentrospora acerina* is a quarantine pest absent for (country of origin)."; or

II - "The fungus *Mycocentrospora acerina* is not present (country of origin)."

Art. 5º The country of origin must communicate in advance, for approval by the NPPO of Brazil, the Additional Declaration that will be used in the issuance of the Phytosanitary Certificate.

Single paragraph. If there is no prior communication, the country of origin must comply with the provisions of Art. 3, being unable to use the alternative declarations provided for in Art. 4.

Art. 6º Consignments are subject to inspection at the point of entry (Phytosanitary Inspection - PI), as well as the collection of samples for phytosanitary analysis in official laboratories or accredited ones by the Ministry of Agriculture, Livestock and Supply - MAPA.

§ 1 The costs of sending samples and the phytosanitary analysis will be under the interested party.

§ 2 The MAPA may allow the interested party to remain as depository of the consignment until the phytosanitary inspection process is concluded.

Art. 7º In the event of interception of a quarantine pest or a pest that presents a quarantine risk for Brazil, the consignment will be destroyed or rejected and the NPPO of the country of origin will be notified, and the NPPO of Brazil may suspend imports of *Delphinium* seeds from this country until the Pest Risk Analysis is reviewed.

Art. 8º The submission will not be internalized when it fails to comply with the requirements established in this Regulation.

Art. 9º This Regulation enters into force on the date of xx of xxxx, 2022.
