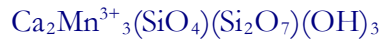


MACFALLITE



A very rare manganese mineral named for Russell P. MacFall, a dedicated collector of Keweenaw minerals. Northern Peninsula.

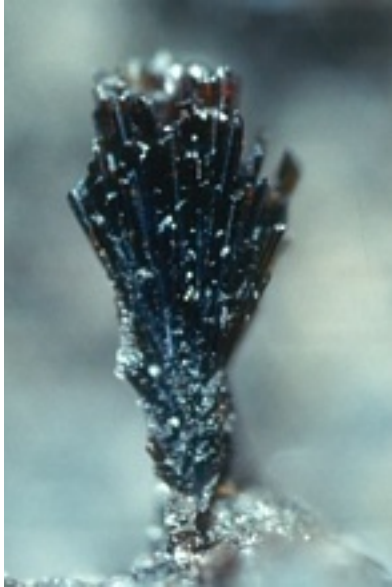


Figure 96: A 2 mm spray of macfallite crystals from the Manganese mine, near Copper Harbor, Keweenaw County. Dan Behnke specimen and photograph.

Keweenaw County: *Manganese mine* near Lake Manganese, about 1.6 km south of Copper Harbor in section 4, T58N, R26W: In considerable abundance with orientite (q.v.). This is the type locality for macfallite and the second known world occurrence of orientite (Heinrich, 1974; Moore et al., 1979).
