


The ancient county of Ceredigion is characterised by its stunning coastline, upland landscape, wonderful wetlands and deep river valleys.

### Take the time to explore more special places...

- 1** Don't miss the daily red kite feeding at **Bwlch Nant yr Arian Visitor Centre** with its stunning walks, challenging mountain bike trails, café with lake/mountain views and children's play areas.
- 2** Enjoy views of the Dyfi estuary, huge shifting sand dunes, an impressive summer wildflower display and a huge raised bog at **Dyfi National Nature Reserve**.
- 3** Discover the **Hafod Estate's** historic "picturesque" landscape of waterfalls, walks and views.
- 4** Take in the 360 degree view from **The Arch's Panorama Walk**.
- 5** Relax on a riverside walk from **Black Covert**.
- 6** Marvel at waterfalls and deep gorges at **Coed Maenarthur**.
- 7** Explore **Coed Rheidol National Nature Reserve's** oak woodland with its moss and lichen-covered trees. The Rheidol Railway from Devil's Bridge is a great way to appreciate this landscape, or use public rights of way. [www.rheidolrailway.co.uk](http://www.rheidolrailway.co.uk) 01970 625819
- 8** Strata Florida Abbey – Cadw Visit the remains of this culturally important Cistercian Abbey with its mountain backdrop. Admission charge from Easter–October [www.cadw.gov.wales](http://www.cadw.gov.wales) 01974 831261
- 9** Red Kite Centre and Museum – volunteer-run Housed in the old Victorian School see displays on the area's cultural, rural and wildlife heritage. Open Mon-Sat from April–September and most weekends in winter. Refreshments, free admission 01974 298977
- 10** Devil's Bridge Waterfalls – private Drop steeply down into the gorge to experience the spectacular 300ft waterfalls. Or try the shorter walk to see the Devil's Punchbowl. Admission charge [www.devilsbridgefalls.co.uk](http://www.devilsbridgefalls.co.uk) 01970 890233
- 11** Longwood & Coed y Bont Community Woodland A community woodland for everyone to enjoy.
- 12** Tregaron town This historic market town is a centre for 'Trotin' – horse trotting and carriage racing, and is a 'Walkers are Welcome' town and includes a range of shops, cafes and services.
