DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Follow all applicable directions, restrictions, and precautions including statements pertaining to the Worker Protection Standards, on the EPA-registered Tilt label.

This label must be in the possession of the user at the time of application.

For control of Helminthosporium leaf blights (*Helminthosporium maydis*, *H. turcicum*, and *H. carbonum*), rusts (*Puccinia* spp.), gray leaf spot (*Cercospora zeae-maydis*), and eye spot (*Kabatiella zeae*), apply Tilt according to the following directions:

Helminthosporium Leaf Blights: Apply 2-4 fl. oz. of Tilt per acre when disease first appears and continue on a 7-day schedule.

Rusts: Apply 4 fl. oz. of Tilt per acre when rust pustules first appear and continue on a 7-day to 14-day schedule.

Gray Leaf Spot and Eye Spot: Apply 4 fl. oz. of Tilt per acre when disease first appears. If conditions favorable for disease persist, continue to apply on a 14-day schedule.

Important: To avoid possible illegal residues: (1) **DO NOT** apply more than 16 fl. oz. of Tilt per acre per season. (2) Sweet corn: **DO NOT** apply to sweet corn within 14 days of harvest or harvest sweet corn for forage within 14 days of application. (3) Seed, Field, and Popcorn: **DO NOT** apply to seed, field, or popcorn within 30 days of harvest. (4) **DO NOT** feed forage or fodder.
