Key characters: Calyx 5-partite, Leaves spinous tipped, Seeds 2.

Description: Undershrubs prostrate; stems rooting near base, obtusely quadrangular; young branches softly tomentose. Leaves 1.0 -2.5 X 0.6 – 0.8, oblong- lanceolate, rigid, subcomplicate base somewhat cuneate pubescent on both surfaces apex spinous-pointed, recurved. Flowers rose or yellowish white, upper lip marked with transverse lines in simple, erect, softly pubescent, 1-5 cm long spikes, usually terminal or short lateral ascending branches. Capsules 1 cm long. Ovoid-lanceolate compressed. Seeds 2, 0.25 cm long, broadly ovoid shortly hygroscpically hairy.

Flowering and fruiting: December – March.

Distribution: India- Ahmednagar, Kolhapur, Pune; Raigad; Ratnagiri, Satara, Sindhudurg, Thane districts.




1. Habit, 2., 4. & 5. Flower, 3. Bracts




