



Sarcomelicope simplicifolia - family: RUTACEAE

LEMON ASPEN – BAUERELLA

Large understorey shrub or small tree to 5 metres Small cream flowers May to September Small yellow/brown drupe ripens April –September Bird attracting

Cultivation: Hardy and adaptable in part shade.

The species occurs in subtropical, dry and littoral rainforest north from the Shoalhaven River in NSW.





Lemon aspen is openly branched, while the leaves are glossy with paler undersides.

Possible medicinal uses of the yellow bark, which contains alkaloids, are being assessed overseas.
