| <i>Acacia ephedroides</i> | | Attractive weeping shrub or small tree 1-4m tall x 2-3m wide. Yellow flowers Aug-Oct. Interesting 'minni ritchi' peeling bark. Suits most well drained soils in full sun. Hardy. | | Mallee |
| <i>Acacia stenoptera</i> | Narrow Winged Wattle | Spreading prickly shrub 30cm x 30cm. Yellow flowers Mar-Dec followed by large 4-sided seed pods. Suits most soils in full sun to part shade. Hardy. | | S.W. |
| <i>Actinodium</i> sp. Fitzgerald River | Albany Daisy | Beautiful dwarf shrub to 80cm. Spectacular large pink and white daisy-like flower heads Aug-Oct. Needs well drained soils in full sun/part shade. Short-lived plant best grown in containers. | | Esperance Plains |
| <i>Adiantum aethiopicum</i> | Native Maidenhair Fern | Easy to grow spreading fern to 20cm. Pot or rockery culture. Does best in moist rich soil with bright shady location. | | S.W. |
| <i>Anigozanthos viridis</i> subsp. Cataby | Green Kangaroo Paw | Upright strappy clumping plant to 80cm. Emerald green-yellow kangaroo paw flowers Aug-Oct. Suits sand/loam/clay soils in full sun/part shade. Good for pot culture. | | Swan Coastal Plain |
| <i>Atriplex nummularia</i> | Old Man Saltbush | Ornamental shrub >1.5m high. Attractive silver-grey foliage. Upright pencil-pine form. Useful for hedging or screening. Prune to keep compact. Salt and limestone tolerant. Very hardy. | | Goldfields |
| <i>Atriplex suberecta</i> | | Spreading groundcover to 50cm x 1m. Soft blue green foliage with red edible berries Jan-April. Suits most soils in full sun. Salt and limestone tolerant. Hardy. | | Wheatbelt |
| <i>Babingtonia grandiflora</i> | Large-flowered Babingtonia | Spreading open shrub to 1.2m. Sprays of white-pink flowers Aug-Dec. Prefers well drained soils in full or part sun. Prune to shape after flowering. | | Geraldton Sandplains |
| <i>Baeckea</i> sp. Limestone | | Robust upright shrub to 1.5m. Masses of white flowers Jun-Dec. Prefers well drained soils in full sun/part shade. For open sunny gardens. Hardy. Trim after flowering. Limestone tolerant. | Priority 1 | Perth Metro |
| <i>Baeckea subcuneata</i> | | Colourful spreading shrub to 1.8m. Masses of pink flowers Aug-Nov. Prefers well drained soils in full sun/part shade. Suits raised beds or open gardens. | Priority 2 | Geraldton Sandplains |
| <i>Banksia alliacea</i> | (syn. <i>Dryandra nervosa</i>) | Domed shrub to 2m. Enclosed within shrub yellow-orange-brown flowers Jan-May. Prefers well drained sandy, loamy and lateritic gravel soils in full sun/part shade. | | Esperance Plains |
| <i>Banksia attenuata</i> | Slender or Candle Banksia (Dwarf form) | Multi-branched shrub to 1.5m. Spikes of yellow flower heads Oct-Feb. Prefers well drained soils in full sun. Ideal small feature plant, and cut flowers. Hardy. | | Swan Coastal Plain |
| <i>Banksia benthamiana</i> | | Erect shrub with serrated leaves standing 2-4m high. Large yellow/orange/brown flowers Nov-Jan. Requires well drained soils in full sun. Drought tolerate once established. | Priority 4 | Avon Wheatbelt |
| <i>Banksia burdettii</i> | Burdett's Banksia | Stunning bushy shrub to 4m. Two-toned orange-cream cone flowers Jan-May. Prefers well drained sandy soils in full sun/part shade. Bird attracting and excellent cut flower. | | Dandaragan |
| <i>Banksia catoglypta</i> | | Compact mounding shrub with triangular leaves to 1m. Golden-brown flowers Jun-Jul. Prefers well drained lateritic or sandy soils in full sun. Deep water once or twice in summer. | Declared Rare | Lesueur Sandplain |
| <i>Banksia densa</i> | (syn. <i>Dryandra conferta</i> var. <i>conferta</i>) | Spectacular erect multi-branched to 3m. Masses of golden flowers Jun-Sep. Suits well drained sandy, loamy or lateritic soils in full sun. Bird attracting. | Priority 2 | Wheatbelt |
| <i>Banksia drummondii</i> subsp. <i>drummondii</i> | (syn. <i>Dryandra drummondii</i> subsp. <i>drummondii</i>) | Low dense shrub to 75cm. Yellow orange flowers at base of shrub Nov-Jan. Prefers well drained sandy, loamy or lateritic soils in full sun/part shade. Bird attracting. | | Stirling Range |
| <i>Banksia drummondii</i> subsp. <i>macrorufa</i> | (syn. <i>Dryandra drummondii</i> subsp. <i>macrorufa</i>) | Round bushy shrub to <2m. yellow-red flowers Dec-Feb. Prefers well drained sandy or lateritic soils in full sun/part shade. Bird attracting. | Priority 2 | Nyabing |
| <i>Banksia dryandroides</i> | Dryandra-leaved Banksia | Intricately branched architecturally leaved dense shrub to 1m. Cylindrical pale yellow/orange/brown flowers Sep-Dec. Suits well drained sandy or sandy loam soils in full sun/part shade. | | Albany |
| <i>Banksia fililoba</i> | (syn. <i>Dryandra fililoba</i>) | Bushy medium shrub to 1m. Cream-yellow-brown flowers May-Jul. Suits well drained sandy, loamy or lateritic soils in full sun. Bird attracting. | | Wheatbelt |
| <i>Banksia grossa</i> | | Slow growing shrub to 1m. Attractive needle-like foliage with rusty gold-brown flowers Mar-Jul. Well drained soil in full sun. Hardy once established. Can be pruned hard as it reshoots. | | Geraldton Sandplains |
