





- b) At least one Apron feeder or Vibrating Feeder, Vibrating Screen with minimum capacity of 350 TPH.

As on last date of the month previous to the date of publication of this NIT, the system or work should have operated successfully for at least one (1) year from the date of commissioning.


B.1 Bidder should be Solvent for a value not less thanRs. 6.8 Crores.

Original Solvency certificate/ Notarised Copy of Solvency Certificate (in original) / Line of credit as per Annexure-6 to ITT from any Nationalized Indian Bank / Scheduled commercial bank including a foreign bank having a branch in India (including correspondent bank/representative office in India) for a value not less than **Rs. 6.8 Crores only** and dated not earlier than 3 months from the due date of submission of the tender shall be submitted in support of above.

B.2 The average annual financial turnover (as per Annexure-5 of ITT) of the Bidder during the last 3 (three) consecutive financial years, ending 31st March, 2017 should be at least Rs. 14.30 Crores.

In case of Bidder being a consortium, the above financial eligibility criteria for each individual member shall be proportionate to their share of work in terms of value (i.e. on % basis of their share of work of individual member), depending upon the responsibility matrix submitted by the consortium along with their Bid as per Annexure-8 to ITT.

Notes:



- (a) The Bidders shall submit the required document to establish their qualification. The certificates issued by the organization (the client) shall form the basis for considering experience of work executed. The Bidder's qualification will be decided based on the documents submitted by the Bidders along with the techno-commercial offer.

Net worth of each partner of the bidding consortium should be positive in each of the three previous years as per the audited financial statements and Net-worth means the sum total of the paid-up share capital and free reserves.

Further any debit balance of profit and Loss account and miscellaneous expenses to the extent not adjusted or written off, if any, shall be reduced form reserves and surplus.



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Remarks:

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For calculating the working capital, current assets and current liabilities will be considered as classified in the audited balance sheet of the year immediately preceding the date of issue of tender.
