



















Beautiful Rosefinch: Carpodacus pulcherrimus: Resident of Himalayas (Uttarakhand, Sikkim, West Arunachal Pradesh) in India Pale lilac-pink supercilium Forehead to crown and nape pinkish-Black lores and eyestripe grey or greyish-brown, streaked broadly Bill dark brown above, paler below Deep pink ear-coverts Deep pink chin Upperparts are paler grey, Deep pink breast streaked broadly darker Crown buff- brown/grey, streaked Coverts edged warmer Flanks finely streaked brown & tipped pale pink Face is brown to greyish-brown Pink rump **Upperparts are buff** Male brown/grey, streaked Chin & throat are buffishbrown Flight-feathers edged paler brown **Female Underparts** Pale pinkish Legs are pale flesh-brown **Underparts are** dark brown **Difference from Male** Reference: Birds of Indian Subcontinent **Inskipp and Grimmett** Important id point



Blanford's Rosefinch: Carpodacus rubescens: Resident of East Himalayas (Sikkim, West Arunachal Pradesh) in India Forehead to crown is crimson Deep pink ear-coverts Upper mandible pale horn-coloured, lower mandible yellow Upperparts are deep crimson Pink chin with darker feather bases Coverts edged deep Crown till nape uniform, olive brown crimson and tipped Pinkish red breast pinkish-red Reddish **Upperparts are** Crimson rump uniform, olive brown Lower back to uppertail-coverts Chin & throat brighter crimson Male Vent is ash-grey are dull buffbrown Flight-feathers edged deep crimson to wine-red **Female Underparts Coverts tipped light** pinkish-red Legs are light brown or yellowish-brown buffish-brown **Underparts are** Flight-feathers finely dull buff-brown edged warm brown **Difference from Male** Reference: Birds of Indian Subcontinent **Inskipp and Grimmett** Important id point www.HBW.com ©www.ogaclicks.com

Common Rosefinch: Carpodacus erythrinus: Breeds in Himalayas, widespread winter visitor in India




Crimson-browed Finch Identification Tips


















White-browed Rosefinch: Carpodacus thura: Resident of Himalayas in India Pink Supercilium becoming white at end Head & crown are deep wine-red, finely streaked white Pink Forehead Fine white or pale pink feather tips on upper edge of forehead and supercilium Bill is brown or brownish horn Upperparts are Greyish-Crown till nape olive- brown, fine dark streaks brown & streaked darker **Creamy buff supercilium** Pink chin & throat. 


Rosefinch Comparison - Male


























