Human Services Community Matching Grants are made in accordance with AS 29.60.600 which authorizes the Department to make grants to qualified municipalities. Services from municipalities include, but are not limited to, the following: substance abuse treatment, mental health services, food and shelter for the low income, sexual assault shelters, domestic violence treatment, runaway shelters, health services for low income housing and rehabilitation for the physically and mentally ill. These services are purchased through contracts with non-profit sub-grantee agencies.

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Key Component Challenges

To obtain services within Alaskan municipalities to provide essential human and health services to prevent serious mental or physical hardship to individuals. The program expanded in FY05 because the Mat-Su Borough population increased above statutory threshold.

Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2007

For FY07, the Municipality of Anchorage, the Matanuska-Susitna and the Fairbanks North Star Boroughs have requested that the Department of Health and Social Services request an increase for essential human services, i.e., those services whose unavailability would subject persons needs the services to serious mental or physical hardship.

Based on the needs that they are currently experiencing, they have requested that the State increase these grants to \$3 million from the current \$1,235,300. The amounts would be allocated by population among the three communities, who in turn, provide a 30% match with local dollars. Funds are then allocated to non-profit organizations who provide the services.
