FEATURES:

- Profuse and repeating displays of vibrant orange flowers from late spring through summer.
- Forms a neat, cushion-like mound of foliage.

SUGGESTED USES:

- Containers or mixed garden borders very bold effects planted in groups of 2-3 plants.
- Cottage, wild flower or rockery style gardens.
- Attracts pollinators.
- Flowers last well cut for floral arrangements.

CULTURAL CARE

Low maintenance and easy to grow in most soil types which are free draining. Watering requirements are low once established requiring only occasional deep watering over extended periods of heat. No pruning is generally required but removing spent flower stems will help prolong the displays. Apply slow release fertiliser in spring for optimum results.

A repeat-blooming variety which brings a warm and cheery glow to gardenscapes over the warmer months. The wispy flower stems makes it a perfect blender for weaving colour in and around other ornamental perennials and grasses. Alternatively create a dramatic impact by planting drifts of 3 to 5 plants. Other companion plants for colour over the warmer months can include varieties of Salvia such as S. 'Love and Wishes' and S. 'So Cool Violet', Nepeta 'Lemon Nip and Penstemon 'Bell Tower Raspberry'. Ground covers such as Sedum 'Gold Blob' and Convolvulus 'New Blue Moon' make colourful 'skirts' for additional colour and interest to the border.
